FM 455/I-35 **Underpass Closed** Mov. 22-24

Starting Friday, November 22nd at 9:00 PM, both eastbound and westbound lanes at the FM 455 underpass will be closed by TxDOT. The closure will continue until Sunday, November 24th at 9:00 AM. A detour will be available via the frontage roads to help you navigate across I-35. Please plan your route accordingly and expect possible delays. See the TxDOT map for details.

Southbound Interstate 35 was shut down near Milam Road after two 18-wheelers toppled over in separate incidents on Monday morning from high-winds.

The two Walmart 18-wheelers blew over a short distance from each other, south of Sanger. The second 18-wheeler landed on the bed of a pickup truck.

However, local police and fire department spokespersons reported there were no injuries.

Traffic was diverted to exit at Milam Road while first responders, including a hazmat crew, cleared the crashes. See more photos on pg. 12.




