

### FM 455/I-35 Underpass Closed Nov. 22-24

Starting Friday, November 22nd at 9:00 PM, both eastbound and westbound lanes at the FM 455 underpass will be closed by TxDOT. The closure will continue until Sunday, November 24th at 9:00 AM. A detour will be available via the frontage roads to help you navigate across I-35. Please plan your route accordingly and expect possible delays. See the TxDOT map for details.

Southbound Interstate 35 was shut down near Milam Road after two 18-wheelers toppled over in separate incidents on Monday morning from high-winds.

The two Walmart 18-wheelers blew over a short distance from each other, south of Sanger. The second 18-wheeler landed on the bed of a pickup truck.

However, local police and fire department spokespersons reported there were no injuries.

Traffic was diverted to exit at Milam Road while first responders, including a hazmat crew, cleared the crashes. **See more photos on pg. 12.**

talks about it. But I am not talking happiness here I am talking about joy. Joy is deeper and more essential than momentary happiness. Joy reaches down into

the very core of our being and without it we are bereft. I am one of those people who do not see joy as a synonym for happy and I will begin on the premise that joy is separate from happiness. Now to connect joy and curiosity.

Here goes. Curiosity is that drive that is often discouraged and denigrated as a waste of time. Children are often pulled away from their curious pursuits with "pay attention!" "why are you wasting time watching those bugs?" "No, I don't know why the sunset is so red tonight". I wonder if Newton's mother told him to quit wasting time staring at apples or Washington's father asking him just why he had to find out how many strokes it took to cut down that tree. Michaelangelo's notebooks are full of sketches of "things" he was curious about. Why, why, why does it seem we discourage this God given trait. I think it would be safe for me to say that every great discovery began with curiosity. From weapons, to cures, to getting to the moon and all the way down to a new way to cook potatoes (yum French fries).

I think it time for an inspirational quote..... Mr. Walt Disney had a very high regard for curiosity and phrased it thusly: "We keep moving forward, opening new doors, and doing new things, because we're curious and curiosity keeps leading us down new paths". The man opened the door on his curiosity and encouraged it in others. Though I can't relate to where the Disney company is today there is no argument about where curiosity led to creativity. Not only can we create new worlds peopled with wonderful characters we

can also use curiosity to invent. According to Steve Jobs "Much of what I stumbled into by following my curiosity an intuition turned out to be priceless later on". Don't always cram their days full of activities you think will interest them let their curiosity lead them. Don't hand them a phone or tablet to distract them and let them play mindless games for hours. I will leave you with two quotes, first Professor Adam Grant sums up my attitude and belief "Ignorance is a choice. Curiosity is a cure. It motivates people to educate themselves." But for those of you worried about that curious cat actor/comedian Tracy Morgan wants you to know "But if there is one thing I've learned in my life, it's that curiosity might kill cats, but it doesn't kill people."

Children? Hobbies? Faith? And, those are just a few

Being curious, using curiosity can help you choose a career? So many would say that logic, nothing but tried and true logic should be used when choosing something that important. My thoughts now would resemble dandelion fluff in the wind. Scattering ever which way. Curiosity - logic- logic- curiosity???? I think I need to gather those pieces of fluff and see what they can create. Let's go for something bigger than a career let us, instead, look at a simple three letter word..... JOY. We all talk about being happy, even our Declaration of Independence





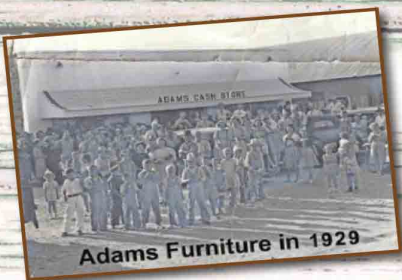
