




#### Dr. George Richard Clerihew

April 1, 1929 - February 21, 2025

Dr. George Richard Clerihew, 95, passed away on February 21, 2025, in Denton, Texas. He was born on April 1, 1929, in Antelope, Texas (Jack County), to Arthur and Claudia Alford Clerihew.

At the age of 16, George earned his pilot's license,

a passion that led him to serve in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. He spent two years flying during the Berlin Blockade in Germany. After his military service, George went on to own an appliance store before transitioning to regional sales manager at Westinghouse Electric Corporation. His love for aviation called him back, and he became a corporate pilot, flying for celebrities



and business executives. He later served as Vice President of King Flight Services in Wichita Falls, Texas.

George was a proud graduate of William Carey University, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and earned his Doctor of Divinity degree from Southern Bible Seminary. In 1966, he was ordained as a Southern Baptist minister and served as pastor in churches in Columbus, Ohio, and Hattiesburg, Mississippi, before returning to Texas. He pastored several churches in Texas, including First Baptist Church in Sanger, North Irving Baptist Church, First Baptist Church in Grapevine, and Highland Baptist Church in Denton. He also served as Director of Missions for the Denton Baptist Association

In addition to his ministry work, George was an entrepreneur. He opened two small businesses: Clerihew Men's Clothing Store in Grapevine and Golf By George in Denton, where he built custom golf clubs—a hobby that grew into a business.

George's passions were many. He was an avid golfer, winning several tournaments and recording multiple hole-in-ones. He also loved shooting and won numerous skeet shooting tournaments. His enthusiasm for both golf and shooting remained strong well into his 90s. George was a longtime member of the Denton Country Club and North Texas Shooters Association. He was also a Master Mason and a member of Bolivar Lodge.

George was preceded in death by his parents, his first wife of 57 years, Vera Lois Clerihew, his brother Walter "Corky", son-in-law Hal Ostrander, and his second wife of 14 years, Gail Curry Clerihew.

He is survived by his three children: Carla Ostrander, Claudia Clerihew, and George Clerihew II and his wife Toni; eight grandchildren: Alison Santos and her husband Denis, Mark Ostrander and his wife Melissa, Sara Schwartz and her husband Nick, Andrea Ostrander, Brian Burke and his wife Jackie Kelley, Breann Burke, Jacob Clerihew, and Alex Clerihew; and six great-grandchildren: Jackson, Aiden, and Max Ostrander, Chloe and William McNeely and Walker William



### Watch out for tax scams



It's tax season again which also means, unfortunately, that it's time for the annual array of scams aimed at taxpayers. Fortunately, by being alert, you can protect yourself from these attempts to defraud you.

Your first line of defense is to recognize the warning signs of potential tax scams. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) cites these common red flags:

Promises of big payments — If you've filed taxes for many years, either by yourself or with the help of a tax professional, you probably have a pretty good idea of whether you're getting a refund, and how much it will be. But scammers, often using social media, may promise huge refunds by essentially encouraging you to claim tax credits to which you're not entitled and then charging large, upfront fees or a fee based on your refund amount.

Suspicious websites - Watch out for strange-sounding or misspelled web links — these can take you to harmful sites, rather than the official site of the IRS (IRS.

Solicitations from charity imposters — The many natural disasters we've experienced in re-

cent years has brought out great support from people wanting to help friends, neighbors and even total catastrophes have also encouraged scammers who solicit contributions to bogus charitable groups. To determine whether an organization is a qualified charity that can receive tax-deductible contributions, visit the Tax Exempt Organization Search tool on IRS.gov.

Threats or demands threaten you with large fines, or even arrest, if you don't make immediate payments of what they claim you owe.

You can protect yourself from many tax-related scams by knowing how the IRS will or won't communicate with you. Typically, the IRS will initiate contact with you through regular mail delivered by the U.S. Postal Service. You can verify the legitimacy of any letter by visiting your secure IRS online account, under the "Notices and Letters" section.

Other ways the IRS will contact you:

Email — Only with your permission, with a few exceptions, such as criminal investigations

Text - Only with your permission

Phone — Only to discuss your case, verify infor- to defend yourself. mation or set up a meeting

Fax — Only to verify or request employment in-

In-person visit Rarely done, and typically only following a letter

#### The IRS will not:

Contact you or take payment on social media. Accept gift cards or strangers. However, these prepaid debit cards as payment.

Threaten to call law enforcement or immigration officials.

Take your citizenship status, driver's license or business license.

Leave pre-recorded voicemails (robocalls).

Mail tax debt resolution advertisements.

If you have doubts IRS impersonators may about any offers or communications, whether supposedly from the IRS or not, you may want to contact a trusted, qualified tax professional.

Also, be on guard for your elderly family members, as senior citizens are frequent targets of scammers. If you talk to these family members regularly, see if you can find out about any unusual offers or solicitations they may have received.

Finally, if you believe you are a victim of monetary or identity theft, you can report these issues using the IRS website at IdentityTheft.gov. You can also refer to IRS Publication 5027 — 1 Identity Theft Information for Tax-







Kason Peebles contributed 15 points and two blocks, while Baylor Beard added 12 points and eight rebounds. Peebles started the game on fire making his first 5

three-pointers keeping Sanger in the game in the first half.

It was a back and forth until with 5:33 left in the game. Nelms hit a step back three-pointer from the top of the key to take a 64-63 lead. Sanger never gave the lead back. Sanger extended the lead to 69-65 after point guard Baylor Beard drove in and made a running floater just inside the free throw line, with 2:36 left. Roosevelt cut it to 69-67 with 1:30 on the clock. Dillon Brown made 1-of-2 free throws with 34 seconds left for the 70-67 advantage. Hunter Mack was fouled with 16 seconds to go and made both free throws to make it 72-67. Roosevelt scored inside and made it a one possession game (72-69) at the 16 second mark.

Dallas had a chance to tie it with 8 seconds left in the game, Roosevelt called its last timeout and elected to go inside and score inside the paint with 4 seconds on the clock to cut it to 72-71. Sanger just let the clock run out and game over. The Indians never had to inbound the ball.

Sanger took on Canton on Tuesday at Farmersville High School. SEE PAGE 7: Canton beat Sunnyvale in overtime 43-40 to advance to the third round. They beat Gilmer 56-40 in bi-district.

## **Indians** advance to regional finals, face no. 12 Kennedale

Sanger beat Canton 44-36 on Tuesday night at Farmersville High School in the Regional Semifinals of the UIL Class 4A DII Division. It was a low scoring affair. At the half Sanger led 17-14 and the Indians extended their lead to as much as nine points in the fourth quarter, but Canton managed to hang around. Sanger head coach Bubba Stastny told his players that an ugly win is better than a pretty loss and to enjoy the victory.

The Indians varsity basketball team has advanced four-rounds deep



in the playoffs for the first 50 years, Sanger's boys team made it to the regional tournament (semifinals) after winning bi-district, area, regional quarterfinal and playing in regional new UIL two divisions (I & II) in each classification, the regional quarterfinal has been eliminated. But, for the first time in nearly

time since 2005. That basketball team has advanced to the regional final round of the playoffs.

Hunter Nelms led the Indians (27-6) with 19 points, six rebounds, semifinal. With this years three assists, three steals and two blocks. Alex Dee contributed 13 points, five rebounds and three assists. Baylor Beard scored 4, Dillon Brown had 5 points and Kason Peebles added 3.

Sanger has not ad-

vanced to a regional final dating back to 1978, when Sanger lost to Coppell (Class 2A) by two points. Coppell went on to win the state championship that year. The Indians are one win from reaching their first-ever state semifinal.

Sanger advances to face No. 12 Kennedale (30-7) in the 4A Division II Region II at Lewisville High School on Friday, February 28 at 7:30 p.m. The Indians will be the home team.
