Falling objects spotted in the sky were likely space debris

If you saw objects in the sky over Sanger, November 9th, you likely were looking at space debris, not meteors, according to WFAA's weather team. Fabian Garza took this picture from the fishing pier at Lake Ray Roberts. He said it was visible for about 30 seconds. "We were all mesmerized and nobody recorded it," he said.

Several people reported seeing objects falling in the sky over North Texon Saturday night, and they got videos showing an amazing display of light crossing across the North Texas sky quickly went viral online.

The light show was described as a meteor shower online, but WFAA's weather team said the moving objects were likely not a meteor shower but probably a piece of space debris breaking up in the earth's atmosphere.

You wouldn't be blamed for assuming the falling debris was part of a meteor shower, though. Two meteor showers are currently flashing in the night sky across the US, the Southern Taurids reached their zenith last Tuesday morning and the Northern Taurids and reached their peak on Nov. 12, according to the Associated Press. The showers will likely continue to be visible through December.

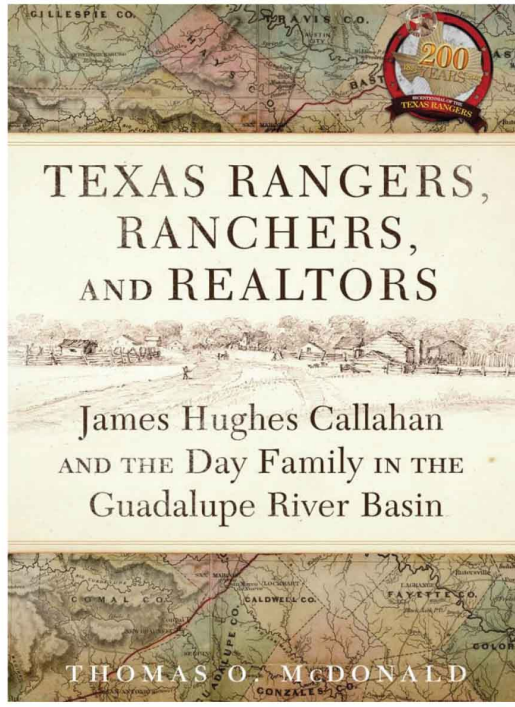

Last week, the Sanger Area Historical Society and the Sanger Public Library jointly presented Dr. Thomas O. McDonald, author of "Texas Rangers, Ranchers and Realtors: James Hughes Callahan and the Day Family in the Guadalupe River Basin".

Tom McDonald is a Westover Hills resident and retiree of Alcon Pharmaceuticals. McDonald is a descendant of James Hughes Callahan (famed Texas Ranger Captain of the Callahan Expedition bearing his name) and the Seguin, Texas pioneer Day family. McDonald traces the family through Texas History and gives in-depth historical research regarding life in early Texas.

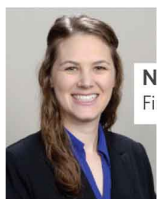

Consider tax-smart charitable gifts

As we enter the annual season of giving, you might be thinking of charities you wish to support. But you also might be wondering how to gain some tax benefits from your gifts.

It used to be pretty straightforward: You wrote a check to a charity and then deducted the amount of the gift, within limits, from your taxes. But a few years ago, as part of tax law changes, the standard deduction was raised significantly, so fewer people were able to itemize deductions. Consequently, there was less financial incentive to make charitable gifts.

Of course, this didn't entirely stop people from making them. And it's still possible to gain some tax advantages, too.

Here are a few tax-smart charitable giving strategies:

Bunch your charitable gifts into one year. If you combine a few years' worth of charitable gifts in a single year, you could surpass the standard deduction amount and then itemize

deductions for that year. In the years following, you could revert to taking the standard deduction.

Make qualified charitable distributions. Once you turn 73 (or 75 if you were born in 1960 or later), you must start taking withdrawals from your traditional or inherited IRA. These withdrawals — technically called required minimum distributions, or RMDs — are taxable at your personal income tax rate, so, if the amounts are large enough, they could push you into a higher tax bracket or cause you to pay larger Medicare premiums.

But if you donate these RMDs directly to a qualified charity, you can avoid the taxes. And because these donations, known as qualified charitable distributions (QCDs), will reduce the balance on your IRA, you may have lower RMDs in the future.

Of course, if you need some or all your RMDs to help sustain yourself in retirement, the use of QCDs may not be of interest to you. Keep in mind, though, that you can start making QCDs at 70½, even before you must start taking RMDs. QCDs up to \$105,000 can be taken in 2024.

Consider a donor-advised fund. If you're inter-

ested in a long-term charitable giving arrangement, you might want to consider establishing a donor-advised fund. You can put many types of assets into this fund, and then direct it to make grants periodically to the charities you've chosen. You get an immediate tax deduction for your contribution, and, if you donate appreciated assets, such as stocks, you'll avoid the capital gains taxes you would have incurred if you simply sold the stocks and then gave the money to the charities. One note of caution, though — your contributions to a donor-advised fund are irrevocable, and once the assets are in the fund, you can't use them for anything except charitable giving.

These strategies — QCDs and donor-advised funds in particular — can be complex and involve several issues of which you should be aware. So, you should consult your tax advisor before taking action. But if any of these techniques are appropriate for your situation, give them some thought — because helping a charitable group and getting tax benefits for doing so is a "win" for everyone.



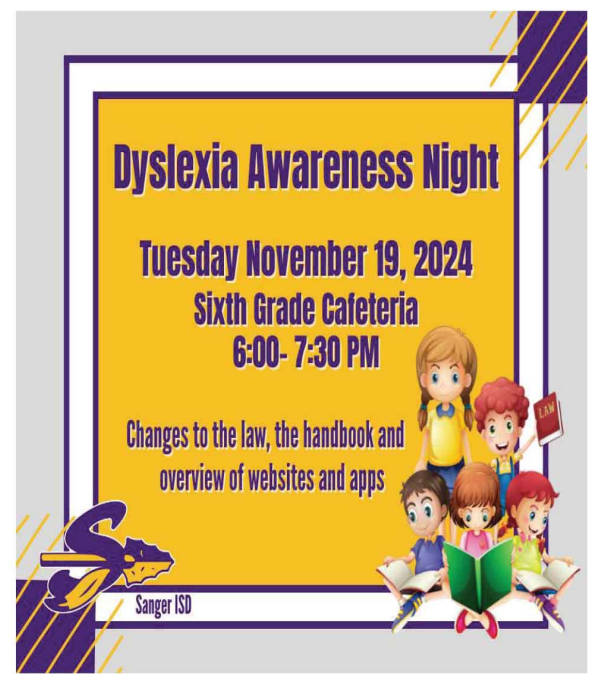

Indians football goes from finishing second in the district, to missing the playoffs in heartbreaking loss

Losses don't come any more stunning — or heartbreaking — than the one suffered by Sanger last Thursday night at Farmers Stadium.

Ahead 38-24 with 1:49 left, Sanger saw the Farmers score twice in the last 35 seconds, the second score of which came with no time left, and win 39-38 in a crucial District 5-4 DII clash.

The Indians (4-6, 3-3 in district) would have finished second in their district with a win but instead miss the playoffs entirely after the tough defeat. Sanger had three district losses by a total of 4 points. The Farmers (7-3, 4-2), meanwhile, earned a postseason berth with their victory.

Farmersville trailed 38-32 and needed to recover an onside kick to have a chance to win. Amare Warren did just that for the Farmers, catching the ball before going out of bounds at the Indians' 49 with 35 seconds remaining.

At the Indians' 11 with one second left and needing a touchdown, Farmersville quarterback Levi McAbee connected with wide receiver Drake Grimes in the end zone with no time left to tie the game. The extra point

clinched it for the Farmers, 39-38.

Van Alstyne won the district and faces Ferris in the bi-district playoff game; Krum came in second and takes on Ford; Farmersville finished third and plays Canton; and Caddo Mills took fourth place and plays Sunnyvale in the first round of the playoffs.

The Indians looked poised to run away with the game in the first half, taking a 21-0 lead early in the second quarter.

Sanger opened the scoring with Kade Phillips catching a 6-yard pass from Daylen Richardson to lead 7-0.

The Indians scored again shortly after recovering a Farmer fumble at their own 24. Sanger needed just four plays to find the end zone with quarterback Reed Sebastian hitting Jackson Gregory on a 10-yard TD pass with 2:03 left in the opening quarter. Sanger scored on the third play of the second quarter on a 3-yard run by Austin Martin. The key play on the drive was a 19-yard pass from Sebastian to running back Luke Thompson on a fourth-and-11 play from the Farmer 22. The Indians led 21-0 with 11:29 left in the half.

After Farmersville cut the Indian lead to 28-21 in the third quarter, Ty Wellman kicked a 37-yard field goal with 11:55 to play in the game to give Sanger a 31-21 advantage.

The Farmers responded with a field goal of their own before Sanger scored on a Martin 1-yard run with 1:49 left to play, putting Sanger ahead 38-24 before the Farmers' late rally.

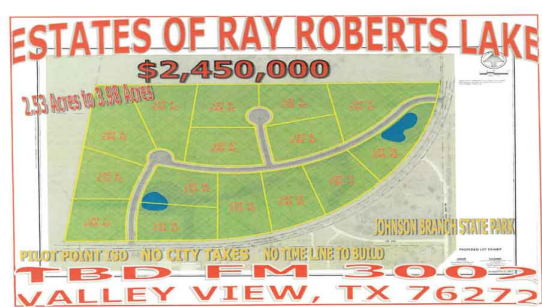
