Election for Councilmembers Places 1,3 & 5

The City Council consists of a Mayor and five Council Members, all of whom are elected at large. Positions are numbered one through five consecutively. The terms of the Mayor and Council members shall be for two years. The Mayor and Council Places 2 and 4, shall be elected in even numbered years, and Council Places 1, 3, and 5 shall be elected in odd numbered years. Regular City Council Meetings are on the first and third Monday of every month, unless the meeting falls on a holiday which then moves the meeting to Tuesday. Incumbent Victor Gann filed for Place 5 on Jan. 24 and incumbent Dennis Dillon (Place 3)filed on Jan. 29. Josh Burrus, also filed for Place 3 on Feb. 10th. Marissa Barrett (Place 1 incumbent) hasn't filed as of Wednesday, Feb. 12.

Date and Location of next Municipal Election:

The next City of Sanger General Election will be held on May 3, 2025, to elect Councilmembers for Place 1, Place 3 and Place 5 for a two-year term.


The utility relocation for the I-35 project continues to move forward. It is anticipated that the utility relocation will be complete in February 2025.

Two places up for May 3, 2025 **Election on Sanger ISD School Board**

Incumbents Cody and Hunter to run again, Drew Hall also files for a place

the Sanger ISD School Board will be held on May 3, 2025 for the purpose of: Selection one each for Sanger ISD Board of Trustee: Place 4 – (3 yr. Term) currently held by Jesse Hunter; Place 5– (3 yr. Term) currently held by Lisa Cody

Both Cody and Hunter have filed for their respective places and Drew Hall, an SHS alum, realtor / home builder in Sanger has filed for Place 5, as well.

Applications for a place on the ballot began on January 15, 2025 at 8 a.m. and end on February 14, 2025 at

An election for two places on be announced at a later date.

The SISD Board of Trustees consists of seven Board Members elected to serve, without compensation, for overlapping terms of three years each. Due to HB 1, School District elections must be held in conjunction with either the city or the county. While candidates run for specific places, they do not represent specific geographical areas; rather, each represents Sanger ISD at large. Following the annual election, an Election of Board Officers of Board Officers (President, Vice-President, and Secretary) by a vote of the Trustees is conducted.

Her mother, Aftina, was a presence in the Sanger school system beginning in the 1950s, serving on the PTA and acting as a perennial room mother not only for Glenna, but also her two older brothers Joe Don, class of '61 and Ted, class of '63.

Glenna, graduated from Sanger High School in 1971 and now resides in Denton with her husband, James. As the only surviving member among her parents and siblings, Glenna wanted to honor their contributions to the school district with this named endowment.
