grade. Michael is 47 years old, and they both still have an affinity for them. When they began in 2000, an oil change started at \$23.00. The exact oil change was \$46.00 at his shop in 2024. "I told a customer that that's an average of \$1 a year," Michael said. "Randy only raised prices as the overhead costs increased. He still kept it very affordable for his customers.

They change the oil on average of about 20-25 cars daily. When you

get the calculator out, they've changed the oil in over 100,000 vehicles. On the low side, 20 a day, 100 a week, for 52 weeks is 5,200, and x 20 years, that's 104,000. Of course, they take a few weeks off each year for vacation. Their customers panic, wondering when they will return from vacation. Randy and Michael appreciate their loyal customers and hope they provided good customer service. They knew the small details meant a lot. "We tried to offer good service and paid attention to the little things."

graduated Randy

from Sanger High School in 1972. He was a volunteer fireman in Sanger in the 1970s and 1980s and always loved fishing at Lake Ray Roberts. He and his wife Toni raised two children, Michael and Nicholas (44). Their kids are also graduates of SHS.

Randy is 70 and still has plenty to do on the family farm to keep him busy. "I've been working all my life, and I need to slow down, I guess."

Michael has a career lined up with the City of Sanger and is excited about earning medical benefits and a retirement plan.




