
rized positions in the Sanger Police Department and the proposed 2024 budget would allow for two additional positions.

The Fire Department has a Quint Fire Truck in production that allows access to 3+ story buildings and the city is quickly moving towards a complete full-time fire department. This summer's hiring brings the department five additional fulltime firefighters and they have applied for SAFER grant to assist with hiring of six additional staff members. Casey Welborn was promoted to Assistant Chief in March and the 2024 budget allows for a full-time Fire Chief. The estimated arrival date of the new fire truck is June 2024.
