



## **Senior Center announces** temporary relocation

Sullivan Sanger Senior Center in downtown Sanger will be temporarily moving activities and Meals on Wheels to First Baptist Church in Sanger beginning April 1. "This will enable us to sort and pack up center before reconstruction starts and during re-



pairs," said Peggy Williams. "God Bless First Baptist for accommodating us during the reconstruction of our building and for the City's support in doing this proj-

The Center's building at 200 Bolivar Street, was donated to the City of Sanger by the Sullivan Family and any Sanger citizens over the age of 50 can use the

Last March, the City contracted the engineering and architecture firm Halff Inc. for an assessment of the condition of the roof. During its evaluation, Halff engineers determined that the roof and ceiling framing needed to be replaced. Additionally, they recommended that the rear of the building remain closed for all purposes, except limited storage, until the roof and ceiling framing are replaced. No immediate concerns were noted regarding asbestos.

The Senior Center will be moving Thursday, March 28 and First Baptist will not be available on Fridays except for Meals on Wheels. Please check in this paper (See chedule on this page), Facebook or come by center this week for schedule. "Laughter is the best medicine and we do a lot of that. Remember how important it is for seniors to exercise our bodies as well as our minds (I'm waiting for my mind to improve)," added Williams.
