Places 2 (Ann Marie Afflerbach) and Place 3 (Sarah York) are up for School Board. Muir confirmed through via text to the Sanger News this week he is filing for another 2-year term.

Filing Period for City:
Applications will be available for pick-up for filing for a place on the ballot at Sanger City Hall, 502 Elm Street, Sanger, Texas. The first day to file for a place on ballot was January 17, 2024 at 7:30 AM. The last day to File for a place on the ballot is February 16, 2024 by 5:00 PM. City Hall regular office hours are Monday - Thursday 7:30 AM - 5:00 PM and Friday 7:30 AM - 11:00 AM. The City Secretary's Office will be open until 5:00 PM on February 16, 2024. The location of next Election will be at Sanger Community Center – 101 Freese Street, Sanger, Texas 76262.

City of Sanger City Council Elected Officials and Terms:

The City Council consists of a Mayor and five Council Members, all of whom are elected at large. Positions are numbered one through five consecutively. The terms of the Mayor and Council members shall be for two years. The Mayor and Council Places 2 and 4, shall be elected in even numbered years, and Council Places 1, 3, and 5 shall be elected in odd numbered years. Regular City Council Meetings are on the first and third Monday of every month, unless the meeting falls on a holiday which then moves the meeting to Tuesday. Access agendas and minutes for all of the Sanger City Council meetings.

Qualifications / Eligibility to File for City:

City of Sanger Home Rule Charter Section 3.04 Code of Ordinances; Each candidate for an elective office shall meet the following qualifications:

- Be a qualified voter
- Be 21 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable
- Must have resided in

the State for twelve months and within the City limits for twelve months immediately preceding the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot

- Shall not be employed by the City
- Shall meet all other eligibility requirements of the Texas Election Code

Sanger ISD Board of Trustees Information:

The Sanger ISD Board of Trustees consists of seven Board Members elected to serve, without compensation, for overlapping terms of three years each. Due to HB 1, School District elections must be held in conjunction with either the city or the county.

While candidates run for specific places, they represent Sanger ISD at large. Following the annual election, an Election of Board Officers of Board Officers (President, Vice-President, and Secretary) by a vote of the Trustees is conducted.

Requirements to Hold SISD Office:

Be a qualified (registered) voter [Educ. Code 11.061(b)]; Take the official oath of office [Educ. Code 11.061(a)]; Serve without compensation [Educ. Code 11.061(d)]; Have been a continuous resident of the state for twelve months and a resident of the district for six months prior to the last date a candidate may file to be listed on the ballot [Election Code 141.001(a) (5)].

SISD Application Procedures:

Any individual who meets the requirements to hold office may pick up a filing packet from the Sanger ISD Superintendent's Office at 601 Elm Street, Sanger, Texas 76266.

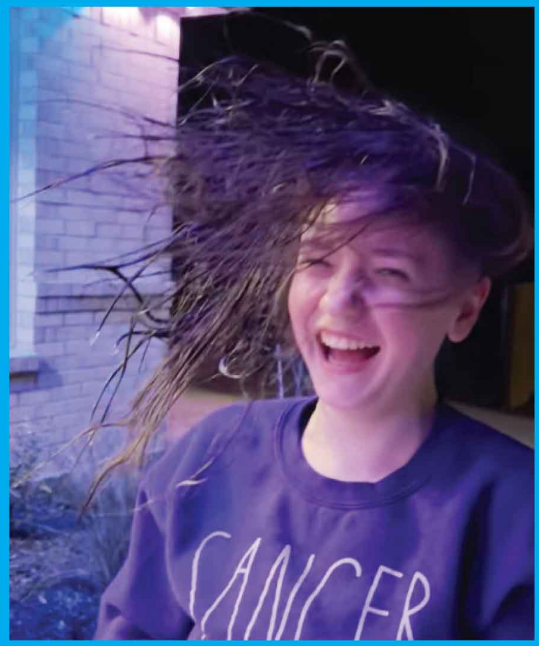
Applications must be signed, notarized, and state the place for which the applicant is a candidate (i.e., Place 2, Place 3, ...). All applications filed are public records and open to inspection upon request. Completed applications must be filed at the Sanger ISD Superintendent's Office. 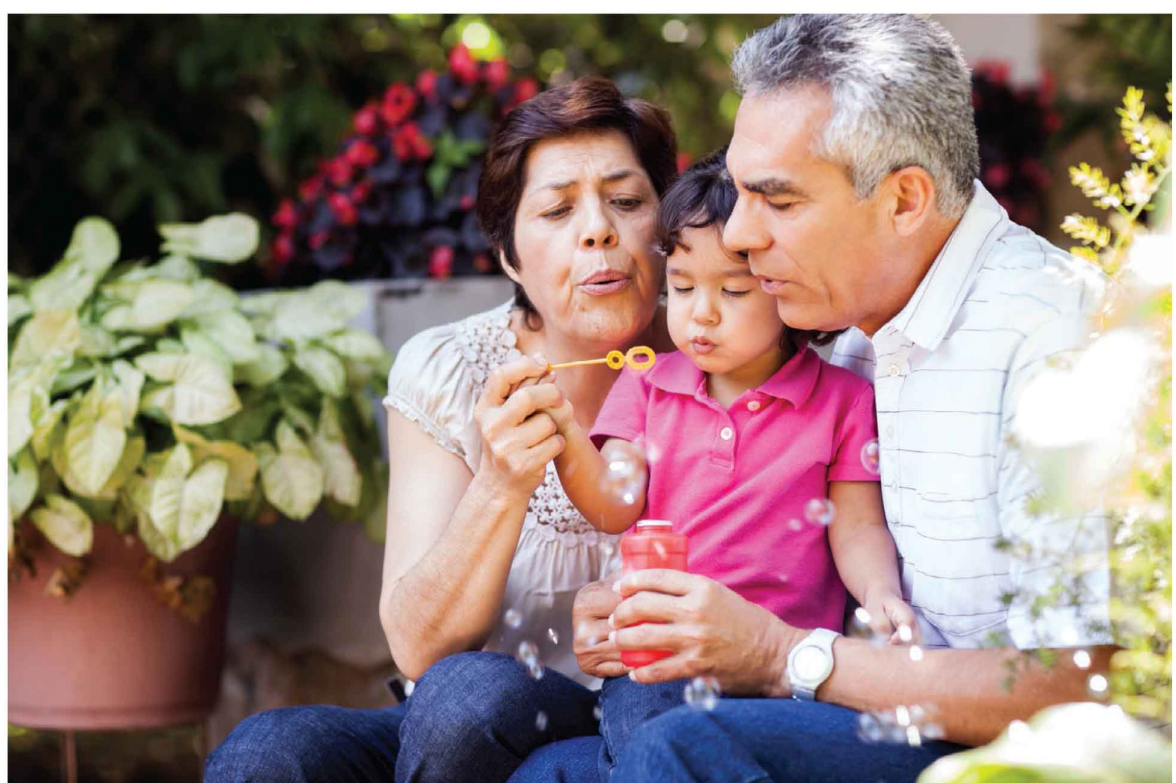

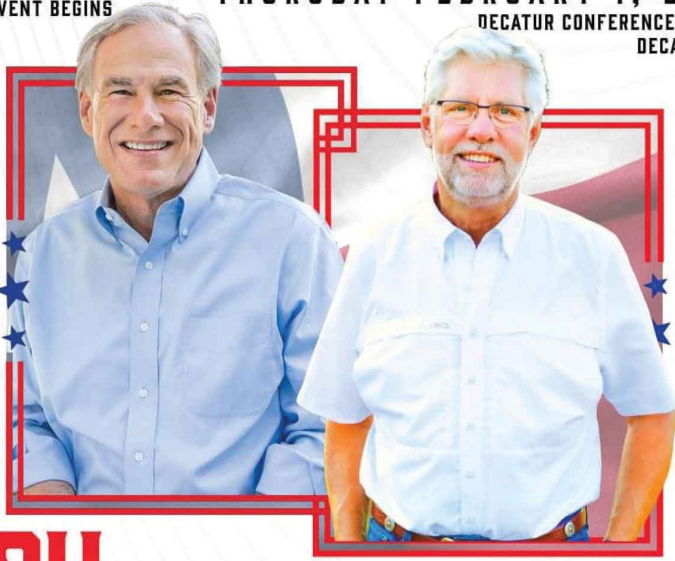

**Consider family
meeting to discuss
estate plans**

At some point, you'll want to share your estate plans with your loved ones — and the first step in this process may be to hold a family meeting.

The best time to hold this meeting is when you're still in good mental and physical shape, and the enactment of your estate plans may well be years away. But what topics should you cover?

Consider these main areas:

Your wishes — and those of your family. Use this meeting to introduce your estate plans and, in a basic sense, what you hope to accomplish with them — leave money to your family, support charitable groups and so on. You'll want to emphasize that you want to be equitable in what you leave behind, but there may be issues that affect this decision, such as disparities in income between grown children or an allowance for a special-needs child. But you'll also want to listen to what your family members want — and you might be surprised at what they tell you. Consider this: More than 80% of the millennial generation would rather know their parents are financially secure throughout their retirement, even if this means that their parents will pass on less money to them, according to an Edward Jones/Age Wave study.

Estate planning doc-

uments — At the time of your family meeting, you may or may not have already created your estate planning documents, but in either case, this would be a good time to discuss them. These documents may include a will, a living trust, financial power of attorney, health care power of attorney and possibly other arrangements. At a minimum, you'd like to give a general overview of what these documents mean, but at an initial family meeting, you don't necessarily have to get too detailed. For example, you might not want to talk about specific inheritances. This is also an opportunity to inform your loved ones of the professionals involved in your estate plans, such as your attorney and your tax advisor.

Roles of everyone involved — Not only does a comprehensive estate plan involve moving parts, such as the necessary documents, but it also includes actual human beings who may need to take on different roles. You will need an executor for your will and, if you have a living trust, you'll need a trustee. Even if you choose to serve as the initial trustee, you'll still need to identify one or more successor trustees to take your place if you become incapacitated, or upon your death. Plus, you'll need to name people to act as your power of attorney for health care and finances. Choosing the right people for these roles involves thought and sensitivity. Obviously, you want individuals who are competent and reliable, but you also need to be aware that some family members could feel slighted if others are assigned roles they feel they could do. By being aware of these possible conflicts, you can be better prepared to address them.

Here's one more suggestion: Let your family know that this initial meeting doesn't mean the end of communications about your estate plans. Encourage your loved ones to contact you with questions whenever they want. You may need to hold additional family meetings in the future, but by laying the initial groundwork, you will have taken a big first step in establishing the legacy you'd like to leave.

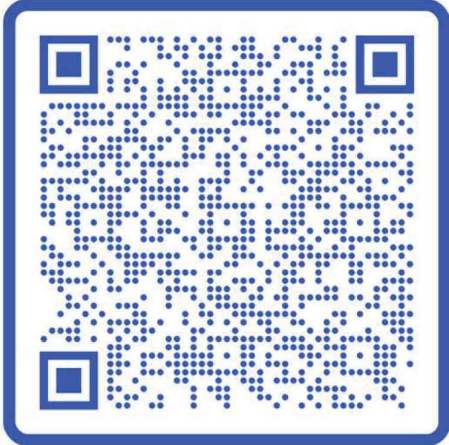

I-35 Utility Relocations RFP-2024-01

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

This project consists of approximately 12,700 linear feet of C-900 PVC Water Line, 7,000 linear feet of PVC Sewer pipe and 500 linear feet of HDPE Force Main located between Sanger Sports Park and View Road along I-35. There will also be approximately 11,984 linear feet of water line and 7,404 linear feet of sewer line to be removed and abandoned. The Lady Indians are very young, with only one senior. "This team's young, inexperienced, but sometimes that's a good thing. It's almost like a blank slate because we've introduced a lot of new things," said Sanger head coach Derek Hilliard.

Indians lose close district game to Gainesville

Sanger's boys basketball team dug itself out of an early deficit with a late rally to give itself a chance in Tuesday's district game with Gainesville.

The Indians trailed by as many as 13 points in the third quarter and seven points with just under two minutes left in the fourth period but rallied to down just 63-61 with 44.4 seconds to play after a layup by Hunter Nelms and 3-pointer by Kevin Thomas.

The Leopards then split a pair of free throws, giving Sanger a chance to tie with a 3-pointer on its next possession.

Thomas, Kason Peebles and Nelms each got attempts off following a pair of offensive rebounds, but the Indians could not get one to fall as they took a tough 64-61 loss.

"We got three good looks from my shooters to tie, and we came back and made a game of it," Sanger head coach Bobby Stastny said. "I told them in the dressing room, they were ready and we weren't ready with three unforced turnovers after you win the tip."

The defeat kept Sanger (19-7, 0-2 in district) in a tough spot through one-fourth of its District 7-4A slate after it previously fell 62-45 to Wichita Falls Hirschi last week to open district play.

Nelms led Sanger's scoring effort Tuesday with 23 points alongside 10 rebounds, while Peebles scored 14 points after knocking down four 3-point shots. Dylan Brown added nine points with one basket in each quarter, and Baylor Beard scored eight with a pair of triples in the first period.

Gainesville (27-2, 2-0) went on a 10-1 run early in the second quarter to pull ahead 28-17 before Sanger slowly rallied and went into halftime trailing 33-26 after a buzzer-beating midrange jumper by the Leopards.

The Indians aim to capture their first win of district play Friday when they travel to take on No. 22-ranked Burkburnett.

"We're just trying to make the playoffs," Stastny said. "We were 0-3 last year, came back and tied for third and had the play-in. It's going to be a dogfight the rest of the way. ... We're still in the hunt. We've got a long stretch to go, so we just have to deal with it."

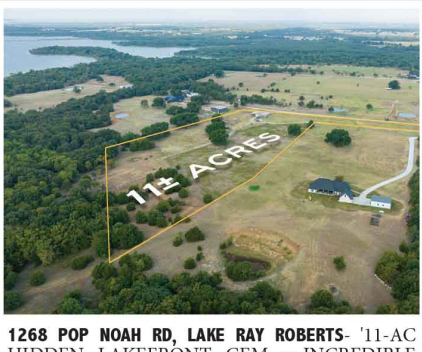


