Sanger's first Spartan Ladder Truck delivered

The Sanger Fire Department recently took delivery of their first Spartan apparatus!

This new Ladder Truck is a fire truck provides five key firefighting tools in one vehicle: a water pump, water tank, fire hose, aerial device, and ground ladders; making it a versatile multi-purpose unit for fire departments.

The Sanger Fire Department is still training on it and the new Ladder 1 will be operational in the near future. A Push-In Ceremony will be held in April or May and the new truck was built with a lower profile to fit in the existing fire station.

This truck will have a lot more functionality to fight a fire from an elevated level, anything higher than 2 stories. This will help at some downtown buildings, warehouses, such as Walmart Logistics, Holiday Inn, Sanger Bank, etc.... Sanger's ISO rating is at a 4 right now and could change for better insurance rates with the new Ladder Truck. It also prepares them for future growth.



Ray Roberts Lake State Park Welcomes the 2025 Bassmaster Classic March 21-23

The 2025 Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic presented by Under Armour heads March 21-23 to Lake Ray Roberts near the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.

Ray Roberts Lake State Park's — Isle du Bois Unit is the designated boat launching site for the 56 anglers scheduled to compete in this year's event.

Texas State Parks will waive park entrance fees for event spectators at Isle

du Bois during the event and the public is welcome for the Tournament Take-off ceremonies at 7:30 a.m. each morning.

Since Isle du Bois Boat Ramp will close for public use March 19-23, boaters are encouraged to use the other ramps located around the lake. The Isle du Bois swim beach will also be closed during those same days. Visitors are encouraged to use the swim beach at Johnson

Branch during the event.

This year's Bassmaster Classic is the fourth to be held in Texas. Lake Ray Roberts also hosted the 2021 Bassmaster Classic, while previous competitions were held on Lake Texoma in 1979 and Lake Conroe in 2017.

Ray Roberts has produced six Legacy class ShareLunker entries (more than 13 lbs.) including the current lake record large-mouth bass of 15.18 lbs.,

The top 25 move on to Championship Sunday, when \$300,000 will be awarded to the best three-day total weight.

In December, nearing the close of the holiday season I was somewhat busy "thinking" about holidays and what they indicated in the old US of A. Well, though I did write several hundred words my brain decided I needed an though hiatus and off it went hopping from subject to subject, with non seeming to take much form and substance as far as the written word was concerned. But, recently, my social experiences gave me pause for thought, so here goes. Bolivar Masonic Lodge has been active for at least 150 years and is a well known service organization having many of the political, religious and social leaders as active members. They are one of those organizations that quietly participate in and help to shape a community. On one hand the members can be seen in our local parades like Homecoming and the annual Christmas Parade. They are the organization that throws out bags of popcorn which the children love. One of their service projects each year is to award to one or more graduating Senior from Sanger High School a scholarship. These hardworking, devout and dedicated men have other projects that support Sanger and its citizens. They support these projects with fund raisers. Recently, they held their fund raiser, the annual Chili Cook-off. Participants make their best chili, bring it to be judged and then sell the chili at an all you can eat event. Not only is the evening entertaining with food and fellowship, it provides a time where major funds are generated. At this point you might be thinking well, so they raise money,

they give scholarships that is good for those graduating who qualify and apply. But, the Sanger Education Foundations does more than manage scholarships which have been started by families and groups as memorials. There are many of that type but the Foundations goes beyond just scholarships. There are three that I will mention here: The Fred H. Yeatts Memorial, the Sunny Yeatts Theatre Arts, and the Karen Hamilton Gunn Memorial. Each was put into place to assist students and department areas. The Fred H. Yeatts Memorial an endowed fund, is used to help our vocational programs (now know as CTE instead of vocational) by being there to assist our CTE students in preparing for a career by helping those who need help, pay for the certification exams they must take. This is only one use of this fund. The Sunny Yeatts Theater Arts Fund, on its way to endowment, is in place to assist the Theatre Arts/ Fine Arts Department with equipment and materials the department needs to function at a helpful level for the students. The Karen Hamilton Gunn Fund (endowed) does somewhat the same for the Veterinary portion of the Agriculture Department. Three funds each of which provide the needs of students in those extremely varied subject areas. The Fred H. Yeatts and the Sunny Yeatts was founded by families, the Karen Hamilton Gunn was founded by her classmates. Donations help keep these funds available and useful as do the various Memorial and Honorary Scholarships (of which there are many).

The Foundation manages them all as well as raising funds to help Sanger students and faculty. The funds buy necessary equipment, supplies and materials. Funds are also used to provide teacher training and other assistance to instructors. This Gala provides a solid fund raising base which enables the SEF to support our schools. Strong schools help build and maintain strong communities. The Gala has silent and live auctions and you see the businesses and members of

the community both providing the materials to be auctioned and participating in the auctions themselves. As members of the community of Sanger we should be doing business with those businesses who have contributed. We should be totally aware of all of cared enough to donate their time, energy and skills to make the foundation a success. There are various committees available which need volunteers. I have not mentioned any names here for fear of leaving someone very deserving of mention out of my list. I'm sure Sanger News will give a complete report of participants. (The complete list of all contributors and donors will be published in the coming weeks).

These are just two examples of what can be termed as Service to Community. But the title doesn't come close to showing the positive effect that it has on our town. When you see people doing things for people. They are giving their time, their talents, their energy and they are making a difference. I've only mentioned the Masonic Lodge and the Sanger Education Foundation but there are many others here in our town.

I would like to close with this thought that each and every organization is made up of individuals and it is individual people who get things done. If you don't have the time, donate money, if you don't have the money donate your time/talents/knowledge/skills. Community is important BUT it is made up of individuals. The next time you are disappointed or disgruntled volunteer to help and see the difference you can make. And, if volunteering is just not possible for you, go by and donate and have a good bowl of chili or the next time you need to make a memorial or other donation don't forget the scholarships and funds of the Sanger Education Foundation. Make a difference take part in Sanger.
