Margaret Janice (Jan) Griffin

December 24, 1938 - December 11, 2023

Margaret Janice (Jan) Griffin was born in Sanger, Texas on December 24, 1938. She was the second child, and only daughter of Archie Milton and Thelma Lee (Seal) Spratt. She grew up in Sanger and graduated from Sanger High in 1956. After earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Library Science from TWU in 1959, she

embarked on a 33-year career as a librarian. In 1970, she received a Masters Degree in Library Science from TWU.

From 1959 to 1992, she traveled the world as a librarian. Starting with her first job in Childress, Tx., her work took her as far as Hawaii, 2 years in Libya (where she was evacuated to Europe during the 6-day war in 1997), and as far south as Ar-



gentina. During this time, she also traveled extensively Anchorage, Ak during the Great Alaskan Earthquake

In 1969, she became the librarian at Ben Eielson Jr. High on Eielson AFB near Fairbanks, Alaska, where she remained until her retirement in 1992. While at Eielson, she met Herbert Lee Griffin, Jr., an Air Force Captain and transplanted Tennessean. They were married in the base chapel in August of 1971 and made their home in the Fairbanks area until 2020, when they moved to a house on Jan's family farm outside of Sanger.

She was active in local bowling and archery leagues and enjoyed cards, board games, and jigsaw puzzles, but her passion was gardening. Her yard was always a blaze of flowers, and she even developed a side business each spring by germinating her own seeds harvested the year before and selling the seedlings to local gardeners. Late summer always brought a bounty of fresh produce from her raised-bed garden. She also enjoyed collecting regional paintings and carvings. Jan tolerated her husband's obsession with aviation and was always willing to help with the airplane-of-the-moment, although her involvement was usually limited to "hold this" or "hand

Summers often brought visitors, who were welcomed like family and were often provided with a vehicle and tour guide services.

Medical problems on both their parts necessitated leaving Alaska in 2020, a separation that neither of them fully got over.

Lee's death in May, 2023, left her to contend with declining health and limited mobility, but she enjoyed staying in touch with friends on Facebook and watching TV, especially PBS and Jeopardy.

Jan died at a Denton rehab facility on Monday, December 11, 2023, shortly after being released from the hospital following emergency gallbladder surgery. She was just two weeks shy of her 85th birthday.

She is survived and sorely missed by her little brother, Joe Spratt, of Sanger, nieces Kim Spratt-Kuhs and Cary Spratt, nephews David Spratt and Chad Spratt, and one great niece, Sarah Kuhs. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and her older brother, Giles Milton Spratt.







Texas laws going into effect on January 1, 2024



A new year is right around the corner and plenty of new laws are going into effect in Texas. 31 new bills and new sections for 13 other bills will go into effect on Jan. 1, 2024. Many of the laws have to deal with taxes. You can dive deeper into each of the bills at https://capitol. texas.gov/, but here are a few of the more interesting

Cost of Living Adjustment for Retired Teachers

The Texas legislature passed Senate Bill 10 earlier this year to give members of the Texas Teacher Retirement System a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA).

There is a 2 percent COLA for eligible retirees who retired between September 1, 2013, through August 31, 2020, a 4 percent COLA for eligible retirees who retired between September 1, 2001, through August 31, 2013 and a 6 percent COLA for eligible retirees who retired on or before August 31, 2001.

The new law also called for a one-time payment

least 70 years old.

The payment for people 75 and older was \$7,500. The one-time stipends were paid in Sept. 2023.

According to the Texas Retired Teachers Association, 186,000 TRS retirees will get \$7,500 and 104,000 TRS retirees pocketed \$2,400. The total cost of the payments is believed to cost \$1.636 billion, according to the Legislative Budget Board.

Texas University Fund

In November, Texas voters approved Proposition 5. praised value cap. The constitutional amendment gives millions of dollars to support research at state universities. With the constitutional amendment approved, House Bill 1595 renames the National Research University Fund to the Texas University Fund (TUF).

The bill would establish Texas State University, Texas Tech University, the University of Houston, and the University of North Texas as general academic teaching institutions eligible to receive distributions from TUF for each fiscal year.

> Article 4 of the bill limits appraisal value increases for non-homesteaded properties valued at less than \$5 million to 20 percent per year. That means if your property was valued at 100,000 last year and is appraised at \$125,000 this year, your taxes will be based on a value of \$120,000.

E-Cigarette Marketing

New restrictions are going into place that would change how electronic cigarettes are marketed. House Bill 4758 makes it a Class B misdemeanor for any marketing, advertising, selling, or causing to be sold an e-cigarette product, including any substance containing nicotine from any source that is intended for use in an e-cigarette, in certain containers that are designed to appeal to minors.

State Song License Plate

You could soon see some new license plates on Texas roads.

House Bill 2323 amends the transportation code to allow for the creation of specialty licenses plates commemorating the 100th anniversary of the writing of the state song "Texas, Our Texas."

Appraisal District Online Database

House Bill 796 amends the Tax Code to require the chief appraiser of each appraisal district to create, maintain and annually update a searchable Internet database containing information about protest hearings, includ-

ing the determination of the protest.
