# Railroad track crossing at FM 455 was not closed this week

## BNSF changed their timeline, the new date is TBD

Starting last Sunday, the railroad crossing at FM 455 was supposed to be closed through August 16th. Due to the railroad track expansion to accommodate the FM 455 roadway project, BNSF Railroad was supposed to close FM 455 at the tracks near 1st St. When they determine new dates, local traffic and businesses will remain open with access in the affected area. However, FM 455 will not be accessible across the tracks. Drivers will need to use alternate routes such as 5th St. (Business I-35) and plan ahead for extra travel time. From Denton County Master Gardeners:  
Diatomaceous earth and how to use it



Diatomaceous earth — a form of silica made from the fossilized remains of tiny aquatic organisms — can be used to control insects in the garden and home. Courtesy photo/Judy Allen

What is diatomaceous earth, anyway? It is the fossilized remains of tiny aquatic organisms called diatoms. Over thousands of years, diatoms accumulated in rivers and lakes and decomposed in the sediment.

These diatoms are made of silica, which is mined and used for many different purposes. Today, our focus is on the benefits of diatomaceous earth (DE) and its uses.

**Environmentally safe**  
When using DE in the

garden, it is important to purchase horticultural or food-grade DE. This is a nontoxic, environmentally friendly substance. A certain kind of DE is used in the maintenance of swimming pools. This is NOT the diatomaceous earth that you want to use. It has been processed and has added ingredients that can make it toxic.

Keep in mind that DE is a powder, very similar to talcum powder. Don't inhale it. Wear a mask and gloves as you find it nec-

essary. It is not harmful to pets or fish, but it is dusty to say the least.

DE is used to help control fleas, slugs, ants, mites, spiders and various soft-bodied insects. Many chicken keepers keep a tray of horticultural DE in the pen for the chickens to use as a dust bath — a great mite control.

**How does DE work?**

Even though we can't feel anything except the soft powder, diatomaceous earth has jagged edges that affect soft-bodied insects.

They crawl over it, and it cuts into their exoskeletons. It also has a drying effect and is absorbed into the bug's breathing tubes or joints. The insects don't need to consume it, just walk over it.

**Nontoxic pest control**

Diatomaceous earth is a cheap, nontoxic pest control. It can be used in your home, in the back of cupboards and around baseboards. Place around the perimeter of your home as an insect deterrent. Remember to reapply it if it gets wet. This can be a safe way to fight those annoying little pests.

**Ants in the garden**

I find DE particularly effective at chasing away ants, including fire ants. When I'm in the garden and encounter an ant pile, I grab the DE. One scoop of dry product sprinkled on the pile, and within minutes they are gone.

It only works when dry, so using it on a rainy day won't really work. It does regain its effectiveness once dry.

The extension and university resources that I researched stated that DE does not effectively kill the fire ant colony. So, I guess they go somewhere else, but that's all right with me, since they are now out of my work area. There's nothing worse than trying to work around ants!

## Changes to Chisholm Trail Elementary pick up and drop off line

Due to constraints of FM 455 road construction

Due to the constraints of road construction, Chisholm Trail will be putting into place a new pick up protocol for this school year. We have been working in collaboration with both the City of Sanger and Sanger ISD Police Department to create a safe and efficient way to drop off or pick up your child from school. Attached to this letter, you will find a map that details the flow of traffic. Below are the details in order to make this process be both a success and run smoothly. Please pay close attention to the arrows for entrance and exit into the front pick-up line.

Pre-K and Siblings of Pre-K students will be picked up in the Back Parking Lot Only (West)

• Afternoon pick up  
• For pick up the gates will open at 2:45. We ask that you wait to line up until after 2:45. • This will be a double pick up line. There will be cones to stop at for picking up your child. Be sure to have your car tags visible until AFTER your child is in your car.

Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd front parking lot only (East)

• Afternoon pickup  
• For the front car we ask that you DO NOT line up until after 2:45.

• You will need to come in from South Keaton. There will be NO entry from the Chapman/455 side of Keaton.

• You will enter in the right entrance as a single file line. There will be six colored cones that you will line up at in a single file line.

• When leaving the school you will ONLY be able to turn right on to Keaton. There will be NO left turns from the school parking lot onto Keaton.

• This will be a single car line with 6 stations to pull up and pick up your child. Refer to the map to see the arrow depicting the flow of traffic. Be sure to have your car tags visible until AFTER your child is in your car.

General Information

• Buses and Daycare will be dropped off on the side of the school in the morning and picked up there in the afternoon. There will be NO car en-

trance on the side of the building during 6:45-8:00 AM in the morning and then again from 2:45-4:00 in the afternoon.

• Morning drop off begins at 7:20. Students will be dropped off in the front and back of the school in the morning. If you arrive after 7:45 you will need to drop off at the front. □ If you need to pick up your child early from school, you will be able to pull in and use the front entrance from 8:00-2:45 PM. After 2:45, the front entrance will be for car pick up ONLY. You will be asked to move if it is after the 2:45 cut off time and expected to follow the new flow for car pick up according to the map attached.

It will take all of us working together with grace, patience, and understanding to make this be successful. We needed to make these changes due to traffic concerns with the construction. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to the school as we are always happy to help.

3. Last 4 digits of the Social Security number of the adult household member who signs the application or, if the adult does not have a social security number, check the box for "No Social Security Number"
4. Signature of an adult household member attesting that the information provided is correct

Categorical or Program Eligibility Sanger ISD is working with local agencies to identify all children who are categorically and program eligible. Sanger ISD will notify the households of these children that they do not need to complete an application.

Applications may be submitted anytime during the school year. The information provided by households on the application will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility. Applications may also be verified by the school officials at any time during the school year.
