## Power Outages avoided for Friday, Saturday and Sunday

The City of Sanger's electric grid was at near capacity and city officials decided to do 30-minute rolling blackouts last Thursday. The City posted a message for residents on its website warning of planned power outages Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

While this heat is hard on us, it also puts strain on our system. To help reduce some of that strain, the City of Sanger Electric customers may experience rolling power outages," the message on the website read.

Rolling blackouts (30 min.) took place on Thursday, but outages planned for 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday, and continue from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday never happened. The planned outages were expected to last approximately 30 minutes with one hour between each outage."

The city encouraged residents to continue to conserve energy to help reduce the time span for outages and apparently, residents complied and power outages didn't happen.

Your efforts to conserve power reduced the strain on our equipment so that we did not have to implement any rolling power outages Friday, Saturday, or today," the city posted on its Facebook page Sunday night.

Sanger residents offered their opinions on social media: "I wish businesses would get notice as to the time of day it is going off. Yesterday (Thursday) was crazy for Miguelito's. Our server goes down, credit cards can't be processed and customer are inconvenienced," said Rose Chavez, manager of the restaurant.

At the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting Monday evening, some frustrated residents at the beginning of the session, let the council know, as well. But, council members or city officials and the mayor couldn't comment in that type of forum. The city is considering having a workshop with the City of Sanger's electric providers, City Council members and city administrators, as well as, invite the public to learn more about their procedures, the process and would welcome questions and concerns.

One man said he was sure there was a good reason for the rolling blackouts, but was disappointed in the communication to the residents. He said he was very informed during the ice storm two years ago when ER-COT went over it's capacity in February 2021. The City of Sanger was also able to keep electric costs for Sange: residents near the regularly monthly average, as most utility bills spiked around Texas.

Tom Reese's Facebook post read: "The city is actually doing this to benefit us as customers. The cost yesterday early in the day was under \$5 MW. During peak afternoon times it got up to I believe over \$5000 per MW. The city eats these costs when we go over our allotted usage. I personally would rather deal with electric off 30 min then back on than be paying like conserve customers for the extra cost. I like most was a little upset yesterday until I got it all explained to me. With school back in and the ac running full blast in those buildings




to with his persistent optimism.



**CITY OF SANGER, TEXAS ORDINANCE 08-17-23** 

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANGER, DENTON COUNTY, TEX-AS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 13 UTILITIES, ARTICLE 13.1600 UTILITY BILLING PROCEDURES, SECTION 13.1602 WHEN BILLS BECOME DELINQUENT, SECTION 13.1603, SERVICE TO BE DISCONTINUED WHEN DELINQUENT, AND SECTION 13.1606 WAIVER OF LATE FEES AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEV-ERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 1. That Sections 13.1602, 13.1603, and 13.1606 be amended as follows: 13.1602 When Bills Become Delinquent.

Payments become delinquent on the fifteenth (15th) day following the billing date whereupon a ten percent (10%) late fee is assessed to each delinquent bill. That Section 13.1606 be amended as follows: 13.1606 Waiver of Late Fees. Late fees shall not be waived for any individual customer more than once in any twelve-month-period without the express permission of the finance director. The finance director shall review and approve all requests for the waiver of fees. SECTION 5. This ordinance and the rates herein adopted shall become effective, charged, and applied to services rendered by the City, and all usage by Customers of the City effective with the first billing issued on or after October 1, 2023. PASSED AND APPROVED by the City Council of the City of Sanger, Texas, on this 7th day of August 2023.


















# SEF Lunch with the City of Sanger to be held August 30






