Early voting ends Friday

Five Sanger area locations to vote on Election Day

Extremely high early voting turnout has been reported in Denton County and around the country and it ends on Friday, November 1. The Sanger early voting site is the Sanger Community Center at 101 Freese Drive. According to the Denton County Elections website, the Sanger Community Center had 5,167 voters through the end of Tuesday, October 29. On the first day, 1,101 cast their ballots; 10/22 - 867; 10/23 - 681; 10/24 - 619; 10/25 - 674; 10/26 - 307; 10/27 - 130;

10/28 - 391; 10/29 - 388. Expect a rush of voters through Friday. Sanger area residents could vote at any of the several locations around Denton County for the early voting process. But, on Tuesday, November 5 for the General Election, they must vote at one of the five designated locations. See the where to vote below: More than 46 million Americans have cast their ballots in the 2024 Presidential election as of Tuesday morning, according to NBC News' tracker, ac-

counting for over a quarter of the anticipated electorate. Both nominees, Vice President Kamala Harris and former President Donald Trump, have encouraged voters to get to the ballot box as soon as they can. With a few days until the Nov. 5 election, early voting is underway in all seven battleground states, along with dozens of others. Reports of hourslong lines outside polling places have already sprouted up on social media, as voters

flood the limited number of municipal spaces set up to accommodate early voting. While millions of Americans have stood in line to cast ballots in person, another 20 million have mailed in their ballots. The 46.5 million early votes are almost evenly split between ballots cast in person and by mail, according to the University of Florida's Election Lab. Some states, such as the key presidential battlegrounds of North Carolina and Georgia, have reported that their early voter turnout is setting records this election cycle. In North Carolina, 353,166 ballots were accepted on the first day of early voting on Oct. 17, beating the 2020 first-day record, according to preliminary State Board of Elections data. As of Tuesday, more than 2.7 million votes had been

cast across the state, according to NBC News. Georgia also smashed its first-day early voting record with an estimated 310,000 ballots cast on Oct. 15. By Tuesday, just under three million ballots had been received. These historic voter numbers are testing the limits of America's early voting infrastructure, which operates with only a fraction of the workers and polling locations that will be open on Election Day. Early voting aims to give Americans more convenient alternatives to casting their ballots on Election Day. In some states, early voting also allows election officials to get a head start on processing or counting votes, to help distribute the workload of vote tallying over several days. Elections and voting laws are enacted by indi-

vidual states, not by the federal government. This creates a patchwork of election operations across the country, each governed by its own rules. Arizona, Michigan, Texas and Nevada, for instance, are permitted to start counting their ballots before Nov. 5. But in Georgia, Wisconsin and Pennsylvania, counting may not begin until Election Day. Early votes made up roughly two-thirds of the ballots cast in the 2020 election, according to the Associated Press. This massive total, more than 100 million votes, was driven largely by the unique effects of the Covid-19 pandemic on American civic life. While early voting data can provide helpful signs of initial patterns within the electorate and voter enthusiasm, it is not a predictive measure of Election Day outcomes.

Man killed in a motorcycle crash near Lone Oak Road

The Texas Dept. of Public Safety announced last week a Gainesville man was killed in a motorcycle crash on Interstate 35 on Wednesday, October 23. Troopers said Dean

Cornelius, 30, was traveling at a high rate of speed on northbound I-35 near Lone Oak Road in Cooke County just after 9 p.m. Wednesday when he struck the back of a northbound 18-wheeler.

Cornelius was pronounced dead at the scene. The truck driver was not injured. Troopers said the investigation into the crash is ongoing.

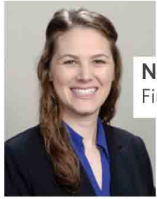

Saving for college? Or retirement?

If you're a parent, you want to do everything you can to help your children succeed in life. Therefore, you might think that one of the best things you can do is to save for your children's college education. And this is certainly admirable, but could it conflict with your ability to prepare for another key goal — your own retirement?

Of course, this would not be a problem if you had unlimited means, but most of us don't fall into that category. So, given the financial resources and income you do have, how should you approach the college-versus-retirement issue?

Fortunately, it's not

necessarily an "either-or" scenario. However, it may make sense to prioritize saving for retirement over college, for two reasons.

First, your children have a lot more time to pay for college than you have to save for retirement. In addition to any grants or scholarships your children may receive, they might need to take out loans. While it's a good idea to keep this debt load as manageable as possible, it's also true that most student loans can be repaid over a long period of time.

And here's the second point: One of the best gifts you can give your children is to be self-sufficient in your retirement. You could easily spend two, or even three, decades as a retiree, so you will need to build considerable financial resources to pay for all those years. Your adult children will have their own financial needs

to address, so you'll be doing them a great favor by relieving them of any financial responsibilities on your behalf.

Taking these factors into account, you may want to direct most of your saving and investing efforts toward achieving a comfortable retirement. Consequently, think about putting away as much as you can afford into your IRA and 401(k) or other employer-sponsored retirement plan.

Even with this focus on retirement, though, you may find opportunities to save and invest for your children's education. For example, if you receive bonuses or income tax refunds, or your salary goes up, or you're able to free up money from your budget by reducing your debts, you could use these funds to invest in an education

This group won three district titles in 4 years and two playoff games. See the Sanger High School playoff game history to the right: Back then, only one team from each district made it to the playoffs.

If you are a relative of a member of this team, they would like to recognize your relatives' accomplishments. There will be a short presentation just prior to the game. The game begins at 7 PM. Please contact Dani Garcia the athletic secretary at the high school at 940-

458-7983. Let her know your name and the name of your relative who was a member of the team. She will give you details on when and where to meet.

The head coach was Leslie Browning. He coached in several high schools in Texas, including Tomball, Saint Jo and Sanger. He served in the Air Force during World War II as a staff sergeant. Sanger residents might remember him as a much older man attending virtually every Sanger sport-

ing event, until he passed away January 21, 2003. Unfortunately, most of the players on the team have passed away, most recently, Joe Higgs, July of 2024. Two members are believed to still be alive: Edwin Ashcraft and Larry Hampton.

Evelyn Langley's dad Al Keith was on the team. He passed away January 13, 2021. As was Chris Odom's father Neal (April 21, 2019). The Nance family has a long history in Sanger. This is a

group with a lot of history in the community. One of the players Billy Ed Nance (October 22, 2014) became head football coach at SHS years later. Virgil Howard and Frank Kerby, along with two Amyx's. And, coach Browning had a great nephew who later became head coach at Sanger, Chuck Galbreth. See the team picture and names below:

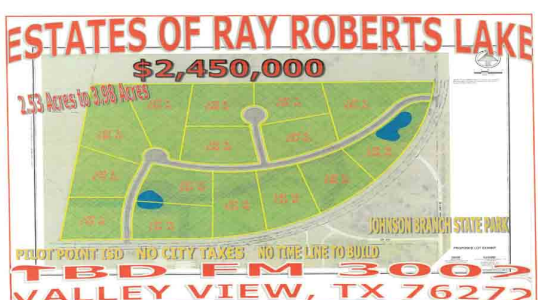

savings vehicle, such as a 529 plan. When you invest in a 529 plan, your earnings and withdrawals are federally tax free, provided the money is used for qualified education expenses such as tuition, room and board, books, and computers. Depending on where you live, you may also get some state tax benefits from your 529 plan. And a 529 plan isn't just for college — it can be used for K-12 private school tuition costs, plus expenses from qualified

apprenticeship programs, such as those found at trade schools eligible for Title IV federal student aid.

It might not be easy to save and invest consistently for your retirement and your children's education. But both goals are worthy — after all, retirement can last a long time and college is expensive. So, try to develop a financial strategy that can allow you to make progress in both areas — your efforts may well be rewarded.
