





## Stucky and Hopper headed for a runoff

porting early Wednesday morning, the Texas House District 64 Republican primary race is headed for a runoff. Candidates Andy Hopper held the lead with trict 106 by State Rep-46.6% of the vote against longtime incumbent Lynn Stucky, of Sanger at 43.3%.

Hopper forced Stucky, R-Denton, into a runoff by garnering 11,723 votes, or 46.7%. Stucky finished the primary vote with 10,875

## **Bolivar Masonic Lodge member carries** supplies and equipment to town of Fritch


