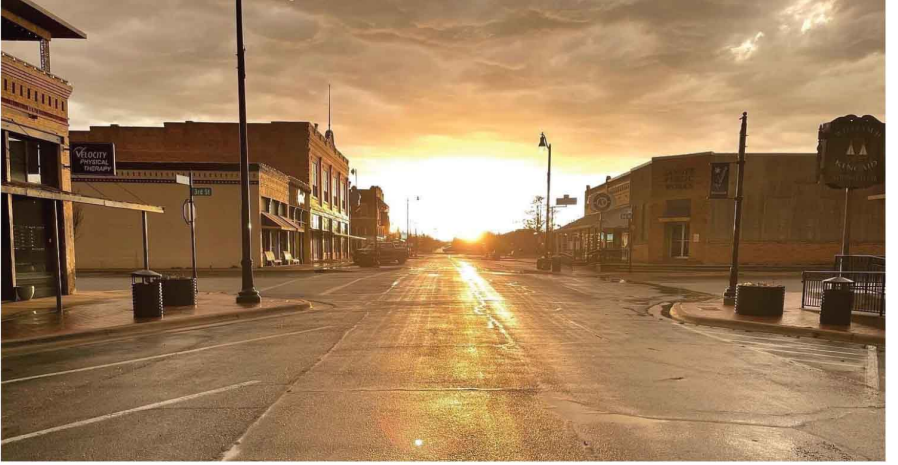

Growth set to double in Sanger



During a recent update report to the City Council, the City staff stated that planned growth will nearly double the number of living units available in the coming years. Among the notable developments is the Belz Road Retail project, which is set to break ground on Phase 1 in June of this year, marking a significant milestone for the City. This master-planned community will bring more than 900 living units comprised of single-family lots for sale, build-to-rent units, duplexes, and multi-family units to the area.

Project Lane Ranch is making remarkable strides, featuring plans for more than 1,000 single-family homes, 100+ townhomes, and 250+ multi-family units. This expansive development includes an assisted living facility and 27 acres of business/retail space. Concurrently, Sanger Circle Phases 6 & 7 and the Sanger Preserves are moving forward, collectively contributing more than 1,700 single-family homes, several duplexes and townhomes, and more than 1,100 multi-family units. This surge in residential development is poised to nearly double the City's total living units, increasing from the current 3,438 to an impressive nearly 6,500.

On the commercial front, residents may have noticed Glen Polk actively constructing their new sales and service addition. Plans are underway for a new coffee bistro at 902 N. Stemmons Freeway, adding to the vibrancy of our community. Furthermore, an urgent care facility is in the works at the corner of Church Street and I-35. These commercial ventures and other ongoing projects are set to contribute 240,000+ sq. ft of new commercial space. City Mayor Thomas Muir commented, "These commercial ventures not only bring convenience to our residents but also contribute to the economic vitality of Sanger."

Sanger is also seeing growth in the industrial market. Anchored by the 278-acre Blue Star Industrial Park, plans call for an additional 8 warehouses and several other industrial businesses to bring more than 339,000 sq ft of industrial space. These transformative projects and ongoing initiatives align seamlessly with our vision and 2040 Comprehensive Plan, ensuring that Sanger remains an exceptional place to live, work, and play now and in the future. City Manager John Noblitt concludes, "The City of Sanger remains committed to fostering a thriving community and embracing the opportunities that come with growth."

Sanger man and girlfriend charged in shooting death of 16-year-old in Denton

A 19-year-old Sanger man and his 17-year-old girlfriend were charged with the murder of a 16-year-old in Denton. Just after 11:30 p.m.

on Feb. 3, Denton Police and Fire were called to an unconscious person report near Denia Park at Roselawn Drive and Bernard Street. Police say the caller to 911 reported an unresponsive male driver with a visible bullet hole in the vehicle's window.

The 16-year-old victim, Ely Mendez Gomez was taken to a nearby hospital but pronounced dead. Investigators spoke with witnesses, including the female passenger, 17-year-old Gabrielle Cortes, who was in Gomez's vehicle at the time of the shooting. All witnesses described a suspect in all dark clothing whose face was concealed by a ski mask at the park. Cortes also reported seeing the suspect with a gun in their hand.

Over the course of the investigation, additional details were discovered that led detectives to identify 19-year-old Marcus Williams as a person of interest in the case. Surveillance footage and other digital evidence led detectives to determine that Williams was following Gomez's vehicle the night of the shooting.

Recently, Williams

was arrested at a business in the 1500 block of W. University Drive. He is currently in the City of Denton Jail with a \$500,000 bond. His charge will be upgraded to capital murder when it is filed with the District Attorney's Office.

A capital murder warrant for Cortes was issued the next day (last Thursday). She turned herself in Thursday night and is currently in the City of Denton Jail with bond set at \$250,000.

Williams is the boyfriend of the female passenger in Mendez Gomez's vehicle, according to the

release, and the passenger and Mendez Gomez were friends. Police spokesperson Amy Cunningham did not know if Mendez Gomez and Williams were acquainted.

The teenager who was killed leaves behind a family who said he was loved by all who knew him, and he was focused his future and always helping others. He was a student at Denton High School.

"He was really into music. I used to play with him, the piano, the guitar," Edras Mendez said to Fox 4 News.

Mendez is grieving the

loss of his younger brother, 16-year-old Gomez. "He had a lot of charisma, he had a lot of friends," Gomez's mother, Cindy Mendez, said.

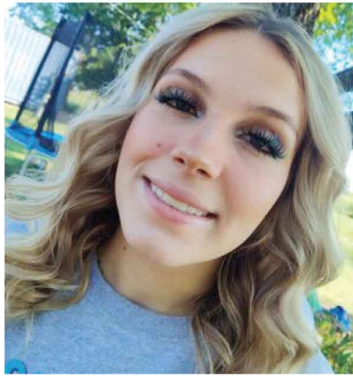

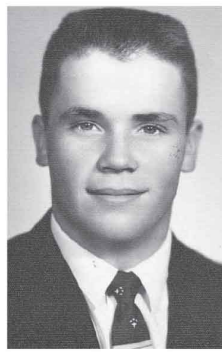

Stucky and Hopper headed for a runoff

With all precincts reporting early Wednesday morning, the Texas House District 64 Republican primary race is headed for a runoff. Candidates Andy Hopper held the lead with 46.6% of the vote against longtime incumbent Lynn Stucky, of Sanger at 43.3%.

Republican
Hopper forced Stucky, R-Denton, into a runoff by garnering 11,723 votes, or 46.7%. Stucky finished the primary vote with 10,875 votes.

Stucky has represented the district since 2017. He represents most of Sanger on the west side of I-35.

Hopper is a familiar foe to Stucky. He ran against the incumbent for District 64 in 2022 and narrowly lost with 49.7% of the vote.

Hopper is a Decatur resident. Falling behind the two, Elaine Hays was also seeking to unseat Stucky. She previously ran

in the Republican primary for District 13 in 2020. She held a seat on the Amarillo City Council.

Sanger is represented by District 64 and District 106 by State Representatives Stucky and Jared Patterson. District 64 (Stucky) line is mostly west of I-35 in Sanger. District 106 (Patterson) is mostly east of I-35 in Sanger. See the zoomed in view of Sanger's district map line below: Also, the overall view at the bottom. Patterson was unopposed in the Republican Primary.

Democratic
As the only candidate, Angela Brewer receives the Democratic nomination for District 64.

She is a familiar face in Denton County politics. In 2022, she lost to Juli Luke in the general election for Denton County clerk.

She has also sought to unseat Stucky before. In 2020, she ran against the incumbent for District 64 but lost with 45% of the

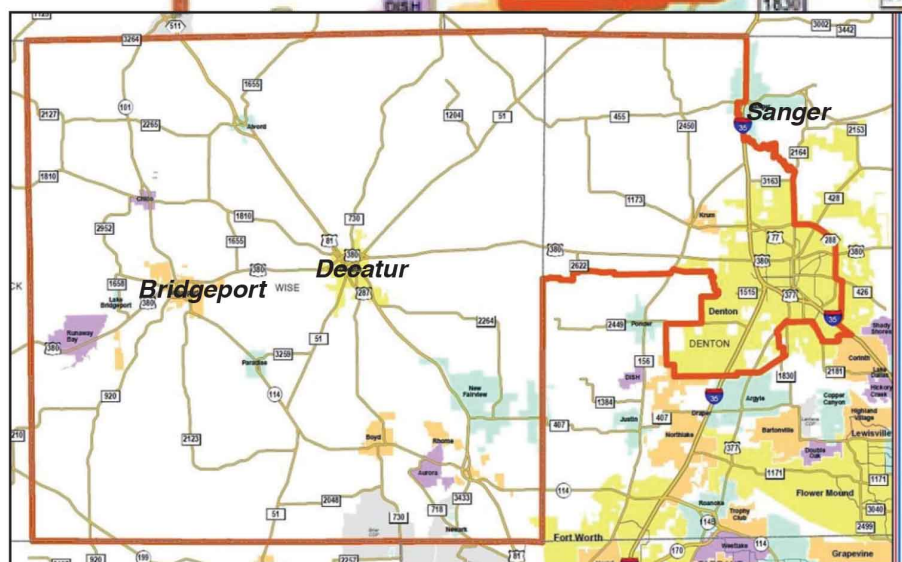
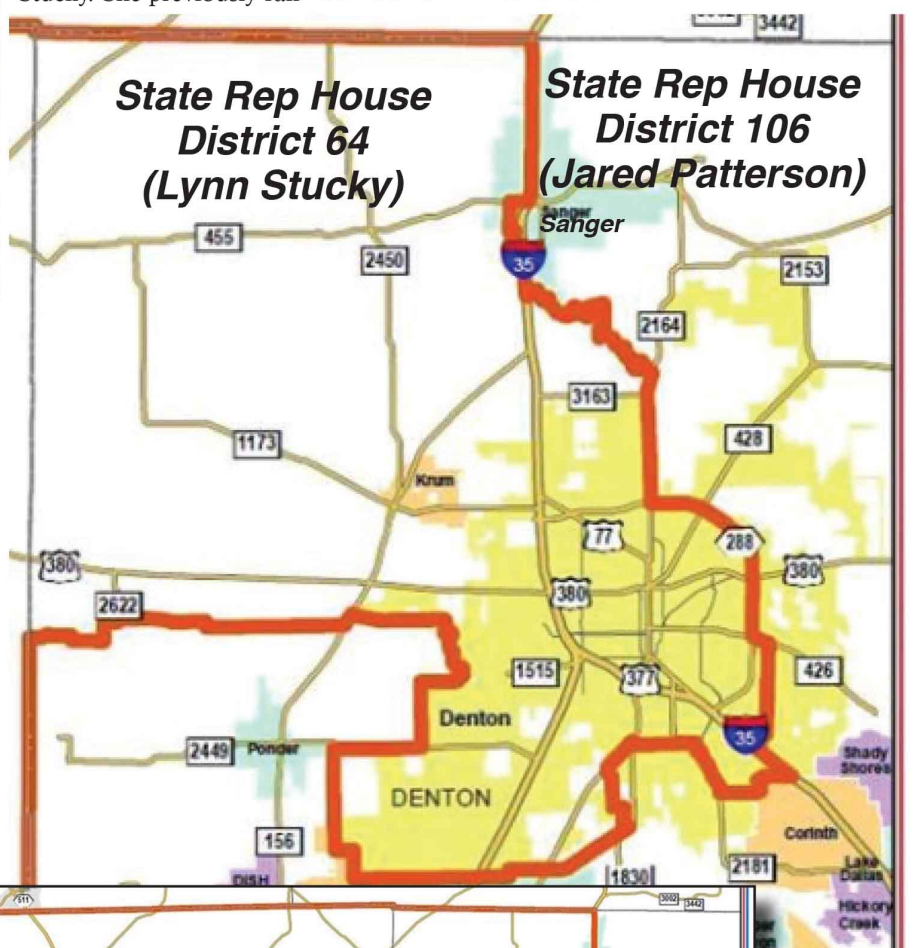
