Ralph Amyx

November 20, 1940 - June 12, 2023

Ralph Dennis Amyx, 82, of Sanger, Texas, peacefully passed away on Monday, June 12, 2023, at his home, surrounded by his family. The oldest of three sons to Fred B. and Marvel (Balthrop) Amyx, Ralph was born in Decatur, Texas, on November 20, 1940.

Ralph graduated from Sanger High School and began attending North Texas State University (now called the University of North Texas), where he earned his Masters's Degree. On July 30, 1960, in the Lois Community, Ralph married the love of his life, Lela Mae Springer. They made their home in Sanger, where they raised their two children, Curtis and Lynelle. This year would mark 63 years of marriage. He



and Lela were members of the First Baptist Church in Sanger, where she worked as the church secretary for forty years, and Ralph served as a Deacon.

In 1963, Ralph began his teaching and coaching career with Sanger ISD. In basketball, he led the Sanger Indians to several Bi-District and District Championships. The signs still hang in the gymnasium on Seventh Street to this day. After receiving his Master's Degree in May 31, 1990 - June 22, 2023 Physical Education, he moved to the elementary school where he taught P. E. and Science. He was an excellent teacher, from academic books or life lessons. If you were coached or taught by Ralph, then you were given a nickname. If you walked up to him today, he would still call you by that nickname. He loved and truly cared for his students. He retired after 30 years with Sanger ISD. When he retired in 1993, he had taught two generations of students.

Growing up on a dairy farm, Ralph returned to farming full-time after retirement. Amyx Farms raised some cattle, as well as sheep and goats. Eventually, he concentrated solely on sheep and goats. Ralph was instrumental throughout the State of Texas in helping many of the youth in FFA and 4-H with their show lambs.

Ralph served on the Sanger ISD Board of Trustees for nine years. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Bolivar Masonic Lodge #418, having earned his 60-year Service Award with the Bolivar Lodge and the Grand Lodge of Texas in 2022.

Ralph was a family man and loved the Lord. He lived it every day by example for others to see and follow. Ralph and Lela followed their children and the grandchildren in all their involvement. In May, he was able to travel to graduation for his granddaughter, Ashton, with her Doctoral of Physical Therapy. He had the best outlook on life. He always enjoyed a good story, whether being the teller or the listener. He loved teasing, cutting up, and laughing with everyone he knew.

Ralph is survived by his wife, Lela of Sanger, Texas; one daughter, Lynelle Stroope and her husband, David of Sanger, Texas; one son, Curtis Amyx and his wife, Brenda of Sanger, Texas; sister-in-law, Elaine Amyx of Denton, Texas; one brother, Dickie Amyx and his wife, Melinda of Sanger, Texas; brother-in-law and sister-inlaw, John and Liz Springer of Sanger. Jeffrey (Jeff) Hunt, 75, of Denton, TX, passed away peacefully on May 29, 2023, in Medical City, with his wife, Becky, and friends at his side. He was born on November 11, 1947, to George Marion and Leta Ruth (Jordan) Hunt in Bowie, TX. The family moved to Denton when George started a new job.

In 1966, Jeff graduated from Denton High School

and enrolled in North Texas State University where he was initiated into Phi Kappa Sigma fraternity. To support himself, Jeff worked at Denton State School and changed his major to psychology because he enjoyed interacting with the residents. When he realized that he'd need a Ph.D. in psychology to earn a living, he made a difficult decision. He followed in his father's footsteps. His dad, who'd been a steamfitter aboard a naval ship, worked in the Dallas Metroplex for Plumbers and Steamfitters Union Local 100. While Jeff

While Jeff was still an apprentice, his mother invited a former student teacher to dinner. After a delicious meal and a date to see the first Star Wars movie at the Campus Theater, Jeff knew that he'd met the love

On June 10, 1978, Jeff married Becky, and spent forty-four years enjoying nephews, nieces, and friends'

Also, Jeff and Becky supported Compassion International, a worldwide organization who found sponsors for families unable to provide basic necessities for

After a failed back surgery, Jeff left plumbing and returned to the University of North Texas to earn a B.A. degree in Economics. After graduation, he completed a paralegal program and interned at Baker and McKenzie Law Firm.

Continuing back problems and other health issues forced him to retire in 1999. Although retirement provided Jeff with time to revisit his passions.... listening to music, reading the latest book, or watching his sports team, he faced a new set of challenges because Becky was still teaching. Like his mother, who loved to learn new things, Jeff taught himself to plan, shop, and prepare meals. A music aficionado, he enjoyed mu-





sic whenever possible, so while he prepared meals, the kitchen danced to the beat of Beethoven, Ricky Skaggs, the Rolling Stones, and many other favorites.

Although Jeff kept busy, he found time to read the Bible daily and loved to discuss the information with family and friends. A life-long learner, he also read whatever captured his interest, and his brother-in-law described him as "one who read widely."

John Will Studamire

September 23, 1938 - June 22, 2023

John Will Studamire, 84, passed from his earthly life and entered the Gates of Heaven on June 22, 2023, at his home in Sanger, Texas.

John was born on September 23, 1938, in Clanton, Alabama, to L. C. Stone and Orener Steel Stone. John

was a steel worker for 25 years for Steel of West Virginia. In addition, he was the first black fireman in Huntington, West

Virginia. Early in life John was a cad-

dy in Clanton, AL, from the late 1940s to early 1950. He moved to Birmingham in 1956. Then John spent 40 years in Huntington, WV, where he married Janet Irene Wheeler on April 19, 1969, and raised his family. There he ran a golf group for at-risk kids,

worked as the golf coach at St. Joseph High School, and helped found one of the first Black Premier golf tournaments in the country of its time (Ebony Golf Classic).

After 36 years of marriage, his wife, Janet, died, and he returned to Birmingham. He remembers fondly how his days in Birmingham and on golf courses around the state, shaped his life.

'Golf has been good to me. I played in 48 states and outside of the country," he stated. "It paid for my son's college. It also allowed our family to travel. Golf is a good way out," he said. "Incidentally, I was a decent golfer. I was somewhere between 0 to 5 handicap (scratch) player for years. If you're a golfer, you'll know what I mean.

Studamire and his son, Michael, "Challenged amateurs and pros alike for a small wager, bragging rights, or just a good-quiet round of golf," he said. They played in tournaments around the country, including two of his favorites, the Bridge Builder in Tuscaloosa and the Ebony Golf Classic in Huntington West Virginia.

John was involved in the Civil Rights movement. He stated "After leaving here, I found out that a lot of places in the North were not any better than the South. They were no better off than we were. In fact, they got a lot of stuff done because of what we had done in the South. The Blacks here really don't get all the credit they deserve for some of the things they did here," said Studamire, who worked as a Royal Ambassador in his younger years in Birmingham. Through the group, he met Dick Gregory and Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr., in addition to heavy weights champion of the world Floyd Patterson. "We have gotten a lot done, but by the same token, very little done. It's, well, rough. It's tough."

Unlike a lot of people who left here and forget where they came from. I didn't. I still have a few old friends around here," he said. "If I'm not on the golf course, you'll find me at the driving range hitting the balls with old, but I can still get it up sometimes."


As you can tell, "Mr. John" loved the game of golf and traveling. He never met a stranger. He loved sitting outside in the garage or on the sidewalk as passersby waved and hollered, "Hello, Mr. John." He would give the shirt off his back to help somebody less fortunate than him, and always had a positive attitude, "We can always find a way," he would say.

His family loved him dearly, and they spoiled him rotten. His favorite pastimes were sitting in the garage with the granddaughters, listening to Jazz and Blues, feeding the bunnies, and eating a good hamburger.

John is preceded in death by his parents, brothers Grover Studamire and Charles Darby. He is survived by his son and wife, Michael and Frederica Studamire of Sanger; daughter and husband, Deborah Wheeler Figures and André; sister Geraldine Studamire Chestnut of Birmingham, AL; grandchildren, Zachary Figures, Danielle Figures, Isaiah Figures, Harold Wills, Jasmyn Studamire, and Jade Studamire; and great-granddaughters, Naimah and Mylah Figures.
