Filing for a Place on the Ballot January 15 - February 14, 2025

#### Election for Councilmembers Places 1,3 & 5

The City Council consists of a Mayor and five Council Members, all of whom are elected at large. Positions are numbered one through five consecutively. The terms of the Mayor and Council members shall be for two years. The Mayor and Council Places 2 and 4, shall be elected in even numbered years, and Council Places 1, 3, and 5 shall be elected in odd numbered years. Regular City Council Meetings are on the first and third Monday of every month, unless the meeting falls on a holiday which then moves the meeting to Tuesday. As of Wednesday, January 29, incumbent Victor Gann has filed for Place 5. Marissa Barrett and Dennis Dillon haven't filed.

#### Date and Location of next Municipal Election:

The next City of Sanger General Election will be held on May 3, 2025, to elect Councilmembers for Place 1, Place 3 and Place 5 for a two-year term.
