

Applications for a place on the ballot began on January 15, 2025 at 8 a.m. and end on February 14, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. Early voting locations will be announced at a later date.

The SISD Board of Trustees consists of seven Board Members elected to serve, without compensation, for overlapping terms of three years each. Due to HB 1, School District elections must be held in conjunction with either the city or the county. While candidates run for specific places, they do not represent specific geographical areas; rather, each represents Sanger ISD at large. Following the annual election, an Election of Board Officers of Board Officers (President, Vice-President, and Secretary) by a vote of the Trustees is con-



Jon Tillman Milstead

March 26, 1984 - January 7, 2025

Jon Tillman Milstead went to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at his home in Denton, Texas.

Tillman was born on March 26, 1984, in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Jon Milstead and Terri Steigleder. Till-

man attended Woodrow Wilson Elementary, Strickland Middle, and Billy Ryan High School in Denton, Texas. While at Ryan, Tillman was a key member of the school's first football state championship team in the fall of 2001.

After high school, Tillman attended Oklahoma Baptist University in Shawnee, Oklahoma, and Midwestern State University in Wichita Falls, Texas. During and after college, Tillman was a beloved member of the staff of Johnny Carino's in Denton, and

Texas Roadhouse in Wichita Falls and Prosper.

His servant heart was never at rest, which led him into the field of law enforcement. Tillman was a trusted, respected, and loved officer of the Denton County Jail, and later the Denton County Sheriff's Department.

In 2015, Tillman met the love of his life, Brittany. Nobody on this earth could light up Tillman's world quite like she could. They were married in March of 2016, and Tillman faithfully and dutifully stood by her side and cared for her until she lost her battle with brain cancer in December of the same year.

Tillman was one of a kind. He was a friend to all, loved by many, and cherished by even more. He loved the Oklahoma Sooners, his friends and family, and being a positive role model to everyone he interacted with. He loved to laugh that infectious, memorable laugh around anyone that would tell him a joke or a funny story.

The most important challenge for anyone that walks this earth is to "leave it better than you found it." Tillman passed that test with flying colors, and we are all better for knowing him.

Tillman is survived by his mother, Terri Steigleder, his stepfather, Nick Turkoly, sister Jennifer Nelsen and her children, Emily and Jake. Grandparents Barbara and Charles Chittum, uncle Smith Andrew Steigleder, cousin Smith Alec Steigleder and his wife, Sarah, along with their children Graham and Hayes, and his stepmother, Betty Milstead.

Tillman is preceded in death by his beloved wife Brittany, his cherished younger sister Emily, and his father, Jon Milstead. He is also preceded in death by his brother in law, Erik Nelsen, grandfather Tommy Steigleder, grandparents Henry and Eva Milstead, and great grandparents Mr. And Mrs. Tillman Smith.



Two Sanger High School students trying to raise money for US Flag Retirement Boxes and ADA-Accessible Playground Project

Two Sanger High School students from Girl Scouts Troop 7847, Charli Davis and Alexa Reaves, are each working toward the prestigious Girl Scout Gold Award—an honor achieved by only five percent of Girl Scouts nationwide. The Gold Award is the highest achievement within the Girl Scouts organization, open only to Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts. Girls who pursue the Gold Award aspire to create innovative, sustainable, and measurable changes in their communities. Both girls recently presented their project plans to the Sanger City Council and are seeking community support to make a positive, lasting impact on their hometown.

Charli Davis: U.S. Flag **Retirement Boxes**

On December 16, 2024, Girl Scout Charli Davis presented her Gold Award plan to the Sanger City Council, announcing her goal to donate two U.S Flag Retirement Boxes for

the community.
• First Box Donation: Charli has already raised funds for one flag retirement box and donated it to the City at the December meeting. This box will be placed at the Veterans Memorial in the City Park

on the Sanger Square. Second Box Plans: The Sanger City Council approved a second box to be located at the Sanger Fire Department. Charli is now seeking donations to fund this second \$800 box. Her goal is to have this second box funded by March of 2025.

Local Sanger Craftsmanship: The boxes will be manufactured locally by Creature Customs and McDorman Signs & Advertising.

Community Support: Charli's project has received support from the Lake Ray Roberts Elks Lodge #2862, American Legion Post #268 of Sanger, the Sanger Chamber of Commerce, Girl Scouts of Northeast Texas, and the Sanger Lions Club. The Lions Club President Brad Allison is her sponsor for the Gold Award project. The Lions Club will help collect retired flags placed in the boxes which will be properly disposed of during a Flag Retirement Ceremony on Flag Day in June. The Sanger Parks and Recreations Department will install these boxes in the next few months.

Alexa Reaves: ADA-Accessible Playground Project

On January 6, 2025, Girl Scout Alexa Reaves presented her Gold Award project to the Sanger City Council, detailing her plan to enhance accessibility at Switzer Park.

Playground Upgrades: Alexa aims to re-place outdated playground equipment with nine new ADA-accessible pieces, 30' x 30' shade structure and install pour-in-place rubber surfacing to ensure wheelchair accessibility and overall inclusivity.

Total Budget: \$165,000, which covers equipment, installation, surfacing, shade covering, and associated costs (e.g., design and shipping).

Community & City Collaboration: Alexa has been working on this project for the past 18-24 months in collaboration with Ryan Nolting, Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Sanger. The Sanger Lions Club, led by

President Brad Allison is her sponsor for this Gold Award project. Lions Club V.P. Geronimo Polanco has been guiding her grant application process. Reaves also reached out to Tatiana Medrano Director of The Miracle League of Sanger for guidance on equipment selection and overall sup-

port on this project. Goal for Completion: Alexa will return to the City Council in June 2025 with the aim of having the project fully funded and ready to move forward. Her Gold Award Project needs to be completed by September of 2025

To make it even easier to keep track of market days, we'll be giving out schedules on opening day. Perfect for your refrigerator, so you'll never miss a market!





Filing for a Place on the Ballot January 15 – February 14, 2025



Election for Councilmembers Places 1,3 & 5

The City Council consists of a Mayor and five Council Members, all of whom are elected at large. Positions are numbered one through five consecutively. The terms of the Mayor and Council members shall be for two years. The Mayor and Council Places 2 and 4, shall be elected in even numbered years, and Council Places 1, 3, and 5 shall be elected in odd numbered years. Regular City Council Meetings are on the first and third Monday of every month, unless the meeting falls on a holiday which then moves the meeting to Tuesday.

Date and Location of next Municipal Election:

The next City of Sanger General Election will be held on May 3, 2025, to elect Councilmembers for Place 1, Place 3 and Place 5 for a two-year term.

Qualifications / Eligibility to File

City of Sanger Home Rule Charter Section 3.04 Code of Ordinances; Each candidate for an elective office shall meet the following qualifications: Be a qualified voter; Be 21 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable; Must have resided in the State for twelve months and within the City limits for twelve months immediately preceding the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot; Shall not be employed by the City; Shall meet all other eligibility requirements of the Texas Election Code
