

Bassmaster Classic coming back to Ray Roberts Lake: March 21-23, 2025



ISLE DU BOISE

The Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic, will return to Fort Worth for fishing's biggest event of the year. Dubbed the Super Bowl of Bass Fishing, this tournament is estimated to draw crowds approaching 150,000 to Fort Worth as anglers compete for a \$1 million dollar purse on March 21-23, 2025.

Anglers will launch their boats at Isle Du Boise State Park just east of Sanger at Ray Roberts Lake. Weigh-ins will be held at Dickies Arena.

The Fort Worth Sports Commission will host the tournament and festivities at the Fort Worth Convention Center and Dickies Arena. The tournament will be a week-long, fishing-themed party with the world championship of bass fishing as its centerpiece.

Only the fourth time the Classic has been held in the Lone Star State, it will get a Texas-sized boost in attendance and participation with an expected economic impact of more than \$25 million for local businesses. Weigh-ins and all of the usual festivities will be held in Fort Worth, the state's 12th-largest city, with competition being held on Lake Ray Roberts in nearby Sanger.

Fort Worth and Lake Ray Roberts hosted the event in 2021, drawing 147,197 fans. At the time, it was the second-largest crowd ever for a Bassmaster Classic and still a record for a Classic held in Texas.

"There was a lot of uncertainty in the world in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic the last time we visited Fort Worth — so much so that we had to

move it to June instead of holding it in March," said B.A.S.S. CEO Chase Anderson. "But the city of Fort Worth was so great to work with and the people in Texas came out and still made it one of the most exciting Classics we've ever had. They treated the Classic like what it is — a true celebration of the sport — even though circumstances forced that move to the summertime.

"Now, we're really looking forward to going back to this fantastic venue during the time when the Classic is traditionally held."

The annual Bassmaster Classic Outdoors Expo at the Fort Worth Convention Center will offer attendees deals on the latest fishing tackle and outdoors accessories from more than 200 exhibitors.

They'll also be able to rub shoulders with legends of the sport like Bassmaster and television superstar Bill Dance.

After soaking in all the Expo has to offer, attendees can enjoy the daily weigh-ins at nearby Dickies Arena, where a new angler will be crowned the Classic champion on Sunday, March 23, 2025. This title provides lifelong clout and a \$300,000 first-place prize.

"We are extremely excited to welcome back the Bassmaster Classic and all the amazing anglers and fans to Fort Worth for an experience that they won't soon forget," said Jason Sands, executive director of the Fort Worth Sports Commission.

The last time the Classic visited Lake Ray Roberts in 2021, North

Carolina pro Hank Cherry was 50-15 pounds — an average of more than 16 pounds per day.

The contestants will be visiting Sanger businesses before the tournament to pre-fish, and during the tournament, as well.

An election for two places on the Sanger ISD School Board will be held on May 3, 2025 for the purpose of: Selection one each for Sanger ISD Board of Trustee:

Applications for a place on the ballot began on January 15, 2025 at 8 a.m. and end on February 14, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. Early voting locations will be announced at a later date.

The SISD Board of Trustees consists of seven Board Members elected to serve, without compensation, for overlapping terms of three years each. Due to HB 1, School District elections must be held in conjunction with either the city or the county. While candidates run for specific places, they do not represent specific geographical areas; rather, each represents Sanger ISD at large. Following the annual election, an Election of Board Officers of Board Officers (President, Vice-President, and Secretary) by a vote of the Trustees is conducted.

Jon Tillman Milstead

Jon Tillman Milstead went to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at his home in Denton, Texas.

Tillman was born on March 26, 1984, in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Jon Milstead and Terri Steigleder. Tillman attended Woodrow Wilson Elementary, Strickland Middle, and Billy Ryan High School in Denton, Texas. While at Ryan, Tillman was a key member of the school's first football state championship team in the fall of 2001.



After high school, Tillman attended Oklahoma Baptist University in Shawnee, Oklahoma, and Midwestern State University in Wichita Falls, Texas. During and after college, Tillman was a beloved member of the staff of Johnny Carino's in Denton, and Texas Roadhouse in Wichita Falls and Prosper.

His servant heart was never at rest, which led him into the field of law enforcement. Tillman was a trusted, respected, and loved officer of the Denton County Jail, and later the Denton County Sheriff's Department.

In 2015, Tillman met the love of his life, Brittany. Nobody on this earth could light up Tillman's world quite like she could. They were married in March of 2016, and Tillman faithfully and dutifully stood by her side and cared for her until she lost her battle with brain cancer in December of the same year.

Tillman was one of a kind. He was a friend to all, loved by many, and cherished by even more. He loved the Oklahoma Sooners, his friends and family, and being a positive role model to everyone he interacted with. He loved to laugh that infectious, memorable laugh around anyone that would tell him a joke or a funny story.

The most important challenge for anyone that walks this earth is to "leave it better than you found it." Tillman passed that test with flying colors, and we are all better for knowing him.

Tillman is survived by his mother, Terri Steigleder, his stepfather, Nick Turkoly, sister Jennifer Nelsen and her children, Emily and Jake. 

Two Sanger High School students trying to raise money for US Flag Retirement Boxes and ADA-Accessible Playground Project



Two Sanger High School students from Girl Scouts Troop 7847, Charli Davis and Alexa Reaves, are each working toward the prestigious Girl Scout Gold Award—an honor achieved by only five percent of Girl Scouts nationwide. The Gold Award is the highest achievement within the Girl Scouts organization, open only to Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts. Girls who pursue the Gold Award aspire to create innovative, sustainable, and measurable changes in their communities. Both girls recently presented their project plans to the Sanger City Council and are seeking community support to make a positive, lasting impact on their hometown.

Charli Davis: U.S. Flag Retirement Boxes

On December 16, 2024, Girl Scout Charli Davis presented her Gold Award plan to the Sanger City Council, announcing her goal to donate two U.S. Flag Retirement Boxes for the community.

- **First Box Donation:** Charli has already raised funds for one flag retirement box and donated it to the City at the December meeting. This box will be placed at the Veterans Memorial in the City Park on the Sanger Square.

- **Second Box Plans:** The Sanger City Council approved a second box to be located at the Sanger Fire Department. Charli is now seeking donations to fund this second \$800 box. Her goal is to have this second box funded by March of 2025.

- **Local Sanger Craftsmanship:** The boxes will be manufactured locally by Creature Customs

and McDorman Signs & Advertising.

- **Community Support:** Charli's project has received support from the Lake Ray Roberts Elks Lodge #2862, American Legion Post #268 of Sanger, the Sanger Chamber of Commerce, Girl Scouts of Northeast Texas, and the Sanger Lions Club. The Lions Club President Brad Allison is her sponsor for the Gold Award project. The Lions Club will help collect retired flags placed in the boxes which will be properly disposed of during a Flag Retirement Ceremony on Flag Day in June. The Sanger Parks and Recreation Department will install these boxes in the next few months.

Alexa Reaves: ADA-Accessible Playground Project

On January 6, 2025, Girl Scout Alexa Reaves presented her Gold Award project to the Sanger City Council, detailing her plan to enhance accessibility at Switzer Park.

- **Playground Upgrades:** Alexa aims to replace outdated playground equipment with nine new ADA-accessible pieces, 30' x 30' shade structure and install pour-in-place rubber surfacing to ensure wheelchair accessibility and overall inclusivity.

- **Total Budget:** \$165,000, which covers equipment, installation, surfacing, shade covering, and associated costs (e.g., design and shipping).

- **Community & City Collaboration:** Alexa has been working on this project for the past 18-24 months in collaboration with Ryan Nolting, Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Sanger. The Sanger Lions Club, led by

President Brad Allison is her sponsor for this Gold Award project. Lions Club V.P. Geronimo Polanco has been guiding her grant application process. Reaves also reached out to Tatiana Medrano Director of The Miracle League of Sanger for guidance on equipment selection and overall support on this project.

- **Goal for Completion:** Alexa will return to the City Council in June 2025 with the aim of having the project fully funded and ready to move forward. Her Gold Award Project needs to be completed by September of 2025.

Switzer Park ADA Accessible Playground Project Sponsorship Tiers

Alexa is actively seeking sponsors or donors to help fund the various components of her ADA-accessible playground project. Sponsorship opportunities include:

1. **Bronze Level Sponsors/Donors \$1,500 - \$5,000 (5)**

- **Equipment Range:** \$1,300 – \$2,600
- **Number of Items:** 5 pieces of small playground equipment

- **Equipment Range:** \$5,200 – \$7,500

- **Equipment Range:** \$15,000 – \$20,000
- **Number of Items:** 1 larger ADA- Wheelchair accessible playground structure, 1- 30 x 30 Sunshade Pyramid Playground Cover

- **Recognition:** Sponsors at this level will receive high-visibility recognition, including company logo signage on the donor plaque, mentions in press materials, and opportunities for media coverage.

Platinum sponsors gain top-tier Logo and Company Name visibility—dedication plaques, featured coverage at public events, and recognition in all key communications.

4. **Platinum Level Sponsor/Donor (1)**

- **Equipment Amount:** \$55,000
- **Supports:** Pour-in-place rubber surfacing (vital for ADA compliance and safe, accessible play)

5. **All other donations** will go toward additional expenses, including installation, site preparation, shipping, and final completion.

Girl Scouts are recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. This means that, in most cases, donations to the Girl Scouts are eligible for a tax deduction under U.S. law. Donors will receive a tax receipt or acknowledgment letter for their gifts, which they can use when filing
