The grant will support automotive, business marketing, and cosmetology programs, aligning educational opportunities with high-demand industries and fostering economic growth in the Sanger community.

#### **Expanding Career Training for Sanger's Future** Workforce

Currently, Sanger ISD offers 15 CTE programs, 80 courses, and 33 industry certifications, providing hands-on training in fields that lead directly to employment. - Cosmetology Establishment of a new, in-house cosmetology center, eliminating the need for students to travel to North Central Texas College (NCTC) and tripling enrollment capacity.






10, 1946, to Louis and Rebecca Fitch.

With April showers come May flowers... and May BABIES!!!

Fawning season is right around the corner! White-tailed deer typically have their babies from late April/early May through June. However, this unfortunately hap-

pens to directly coincide with the start of the busy season for the park!

Why can this be a problem? When momma deer goes to graze, she will often tuck her baby away somewhere she thinks is safe. The baby will instinctively stay where they are, quiet and still, until mom returns. Great for avoiding predators-- awful for avoiding humans!

We understand a baby deer seemingly on its own can be concerning to some, but rest assured they are NOT hurt, and they are NOT abandoned. Momma deer knows exactly where her baby is! Touching or moving the baby could bring it into increased danger from predators or even cause it to be rejected by mom. If you are worried about a baby deer being located in a public area, please contact a park ranger so that it can be handled properly.

Remember: If you see it alone-- leave it alone!
