### Several new businesses slated for Sanger

There's a lot happening in Sanger... Jack in the box has poured the foundation for their new fast-food restaurant. It will be located next to Holiday Inn Express. Sanger Bank purchased the EIKON building at 1405 West Chapman Drive last year and is completely remodeling it. They are hoping to be relocated before the end of 2023. In other local business news - QT is opening in a few weeks and Starbucks next month. A new medical office, owned by Dr. Reed on Chapman Drive is near completion; Some new restaurants are opening in Sanger - Villa Grande Mexican Restaurant will open next to Roma's Italian and Bear's Cafe will open soon in downtown Sanger, where K's Gourmet was located.

And lastly, AutoZone and Scooter's Coffee are slated for Sanger. Scooter's will be located at the old Snap Shop site on the northeast side of I-35 & FM 455. AutoZone has purchased the commercial property next to Dr. Richard Perry's Office on west Chap-

And yes, the City of Sanger has negotiated a national chain grocery store to be built on property purchased behind the current Jack in the Box. Developers aren't able to announce the name and it could be a few years before construction begins on the retail shopping center. The 131 acre residential and commercial development zoning change was approved last December by the City Council.





### Retired? Consider benefits of part-time work

After spending decades in the workforce, vou might look forward to the day you retire. But if vou decide, for one reason or another, that you'd like to redefine "retirement" to include part-time work or consulting, you could enjoy exercising your skills and meeting new people. But you can also receive some key financial benefits

Specifically, bringing in some paychecks in your retirement can help you in these areas:

You could contribute more to your IRA. During your working years, you may have contributed regularly to an IRA, but once you retired, you might have thought those days were over. But there's no age limit - if you have any earned income, you

can contribute to an IRA more than college – it can and boost the financial resources you have available for retirement.

You could potentialrate. Once you're retired, you will likely need to rely on your investment portfolio to provide you with some – or maybe most – of your income. Consequently, you'll need to establish an appropriate withdrawal rate – a percentage of your portfolio that you can take out each year without running the risk of potentially outliving your money. Income from part-time work or consulting may lower your dependency on investment income, thereby reducing your anextending the overall longevity of your investment portfolio.

You could add to your grandchildren's 529 plans. When you invest in a 529 education savings plan, the earnings and withdrawals are federally tax-free, provided the money is used for qualified education expenses. As a grandparent, you can contribute to a 529 plan with your grandchildren as beneficiaries. And a 529 plan can be used for

fund some programs at trade schools and K-12 expenses in some states. So, by putting some of your ly lower your withdrawal earned income to work in a 529 plan, you can help improve your grandchil-

dren's prospects. You could reduce your debts. By the time you reach retirement, you may or may not have retired your mortgage, but you might have other debts on your books. If you can apply some of your earned income to these debts, you can improve your cash flow and possibly avoid dipping into your retirement accounts for shortterm needs.

Of course, you'll also nual withdrawal rate and have to consider some issues if you end up working in retirement, particularly if you bring in a sizable amount of money. For example, if you're earning income and collecting Social Security before you reach your "full" retirement age - which is likely between 66 and 67 - your monthly benefits will be reduced. (However, these "lost" benefits will be restored once you do reach your full retirement age.) Also, the added income could push you into a higher tax bracket or even cause you to pay the Medicare premium surcharge or the 3.8% surtax on net investment income if your income reaches certain levels. So, before embarking on any employment that may yield a large additional income, consult with your tax advisor.

> Overall, though, the financial benefits of parttime employment income during your retirement years may be worth it – so give some thought to "unretiring."

At the conservation (normal) pool elevation of 632.5 feet NGVD, the lake surface covers 28,646 acres. Ray Roberts dam, an earthen structure 141 feet high, is owned and operated by the United States Army Corps of Engineers. Ray Roberts Lake is home to many parks and recreation areas and includes boat ramps, trails, hiking, fishing, and other recreation opportunities. It was named after Ray Roberts (a local congressman who supported creation of the lake) in 1980. The lake took less than a year to fill up.
