Muir wins Mayor's race and Bilyeu is re-elected

Thomas Muir won his eighth election to be Sanger Mayor on Saturday, May 4. He tallied 150 votes to Jeffrey W. Jaracke's 79, (229) total votes. Jaracke is a retired fireman and this was his second time to run for Mayor. In 2022, Muir won 487-246 (727) total votes. In 2022 there was more of a turnout because of the Sanger ISD bond, which accumulated 1,656 votes. Citizens have to live in the city limits to vote for council or mayor, which is why it was about half the total of the school bond turnout.

"Thank you to all the Sanger residents that came out and voted during the recent city election. Sanger is a special place -- where your elected officials volunteer their time on Council with a focus on making decisions each believes is in the best inter-

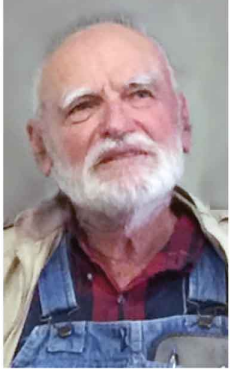

est of our city,” said Muir. “I so appreciate their time and continued service. As your Mayor, I want to thank the Council, city staff, and those that serve on our boards for each playing a key role in planning and implementing positive initiatives on behalf of all residents. As a community, Sanger is growing and vibrant. This certainly comes with some ‘growing pains’ as we work to improve our core infrastructure, support businesses, and strive to bring new amenities that Sanger residents desire. Thank you for trusting your Council with these endeavors; we are humbled and will continue to work diligently on your behalf.”

Gary Bilyeu narrowly got by Lisa Freeman for City Council Place 2 on Saturday 116-104 votes (220 total) and Allen Chick was unopposed for Place 4. Bilyeu has been a councilman since May of 2010 and Chick’s first term was 2014.

There wasn’t an election for School Board. Both, Sarah York and Stacy Moore were unopposed for their respective places. York has been on the board since 2018 and this is Moore’s first run on the School Board.

Lady Indians beat Stephenville, play Krum in third round of the playoffs

Sanger High School's varsity softball team is in the third round of the playoffs again with a sweep of Stephenville last week. Sanger, who's ranked in the top 10 in the state now, faces no. 6 ranked Krum this week at Denton Bronco Field.

Krum notched its second straight district title, winning outright this time around after sharing the championship with Decatur last year. Sanger won its first outright district title since 2014 and has reached Round 3 of the playoffs for the second consecutive season.

Krum and Sanger (no. 8 in the state) have two of the area's three softball

state championships, as the Lady Cats won the 4A title in 2017 and Sanger took home the 3A trophy in 2001. The pair of programs won it all in their lone trips to the state tournament thus far.

The winner of Krum and Sanger's series could also have the inside track to getting out of Region I-4A, though they will certainly face some competition in that regard. Whoever wins the series appears likely to face No. 9-ranked Dumas in next week's regional semifinal round, then could potentially face No. 6 Snyder in the regional championship game.

Sanger 9, Stephenville 7

The Lady Indians traded blows with Stephenville several times during last Thursday's Region I-4A area round opener, but ultimately found a way to prevail in the high-scoring contest.

Sanger (30-5), which entered the playoffs ranked No. 14 in Class 4A, found itself down 1-0 through the top of the first inning and 2-1 entering the bottom of the second before plating three runs in the half-inning to take its first lead. Stephenville rallied to tie at 4-4, but the Lady Indians scored five runs in the fourth to pull ahead 9-4 and fended off Stephenville's late surge.

Dalilah Millan helped lead the way by going 2 for 4 with a double and three RBIs, while Vivianne Lynch was 2 for 2 with a home run, two RBIs and two runs scored. Makynna Meeks went 3 for 4 with a double, two RBIs and two runs scored, while Leala Kloewer and Lily Wilson had one RBI each. Piper Lindlau, Sophia Troegle and Kyle Cochran each doubled as well.

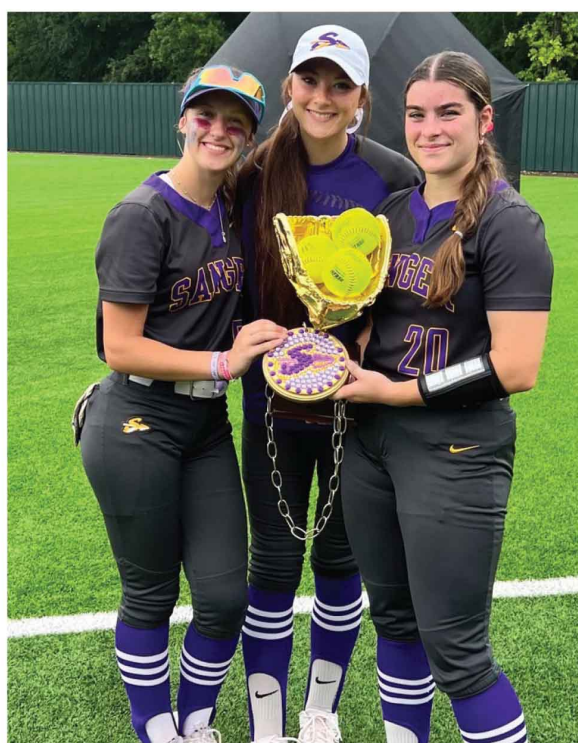
Kloewer recorded all 21 outs despite a brief exit, tallying 12 strikeouts while surrendering eight hits, three walks and five earned runs.
