Muir wins Mayor's race and Bilyeu is re-elected

Thomas Muir won his eighth election to be Sanger Mayor on Saturday, May 4. He tallied 150 votes to Jeffrey W. Jaracke's 79, (229) total votes. Jaracke is a retired fireman and this was he second time to vy for Mayor. In 2022, Muir won 487-246 (727) total votes. In 2022 there was more of a turnout because of the Sanger ISD bond, which accumulated 1,656 votes. Citizens have to live in the city limits to vote for council or mayor, which is why it was about half the total of the school bond turnout.


Kloewer recorded all 21 outs despite a brief exit, tallying 12 strikeouts while surrendering eight hits, three walks and five earned runs.
