VLK Architects and Sanger ISD Celebrate the Start of Construction for SHS

On Wednesday, October 25, 2023, VLK Architects joined Sanger Independent School District for the groundbreaking of the new Sanger High School replacement campus.

The 280,000 sf., campus will have a capacity of 1,400 students and include four academic wings and a centrally located administration suite. Three wings contain core subjects, science labs, small collaboration spaces, and a 100-seat lecture hall. The fourth wing contains Career and Technology Education spaces that include a culinary lab and bistro, a floral design lab and an audio/video lab. The campus is arranged around a large, secured outdoor courtyard that can be used by students during the day or for after school events.

"After a year of design work collaborating with students and staff of Sanger ISD, the City of Sanger and Pogue Construction, VLK is excited to see construction begin on the new Sanger High School," said John Klein, VLK Principal. "This

building will provide the district with decades of service to its students, helping shape the future of Sanger itself. We take pride that VLK was chosen to be included as part of this journey."

The new building fea-

tures a traditional design with components such as cast stone accents, brick masonry, and a central entry tower. The campus will also feature a competition gymnasium, a storm shelter, and a new athletic field house.

"We want to lead the way in education by showing continued growth and improvement for our students because that is what they deserve, and this campus is proof of that commitment," said Dr. Tommy Hunter, Super-

intendent of Sanger ISD. "This state-of-the-art high school will give our students a top-notch educational experience that will prepare them for life after high school. It will be a facility that this town will be proud of for many genera-

tions to come." The funding for the new Sanger High School campus was included in the May 2022 bond and is expected to open its doors at the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

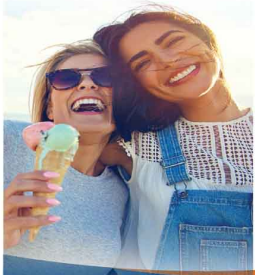

Bolivar Cemetery Association has partnered with "Remember Them Forever" to honor veterans

The Bolivar Cemetery Association has recently partnered with "Remember Them Forever", an organization whose mission is; To honor all Texas Veterans for their service, sacrifices and accomplishments; To preserve the history and stories of our Texas Veterans; To educate the public on those stories.

The Texas Veterans Hall of Fame was founded in 2018 out of the efforts to preserve the history of the 1.8 million Texans that have served since the beginning of WWI. Texas is deep in military history with museums scattered all over the State. However, none of these organizations are exclusively dedicated to honoring Texas Military Veterans for their outstanding service, sacrifices and accomplishments

on an individual basis. Now Texas has that venue with the Texas Veterans Hall of Fame.

All veteran gravesites in the Bolivar Cemetery have been identified and entered into their database, along with latitude and longitude points so that graves can easily be found. The Cemetery is currently trying to raise \$2000 to mark all of the military graves. Each marker is 6" x 6", that be placed close to the headstone. Each marker also has a slot to hold a small American flag. On the back of the marker there is a plastic QR code that visitors can scan with their smart phone to read a short biography about that veteran. People can sponsor their relatives or just choose to sponsor a certain number of veterans. Organizations can also donate to this cause.

To sponsor, use this QR code. Each veteran marker is \$12.00

No more one-and-one free throws in high school and middle school basketball

One-and-ones are done in high school basketball. Beginning this season, high school basketball teams will shoot two free throws for common fouls when in the "bonus" instead of having to make the first free throw to get a second after seven fouls.

Rules changes were approved by the National Federation of State High School Associations' (NFHS) basketball rules committee, then by the NFHS board of directors.

The NFHS announced the changes in May. In addition to awarding two foul shots for all common fouls, teams will reach the bonus when their opponent commits five fouls in each quarter and team fouls will reset at the end of each quarter.

The old rules awarded the one-and-one bonus when an opponent committed seven fouls in a half and two foul

shots when 10 fouls were committed each half. Lindsey Atkinson, NFHS director of sports, said in a statement that the rules committee studied data that showed higher injury rates on rebounding situations, so it seized as an opportunity to reduce opportunities for rough play. Atkinson also believes that resetting the fouls each quarter will improve game flow.

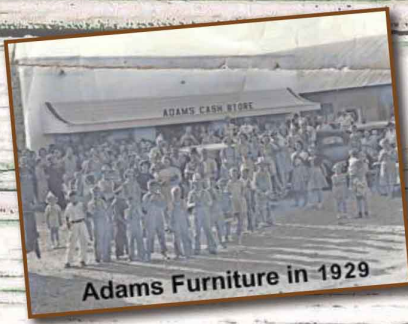
