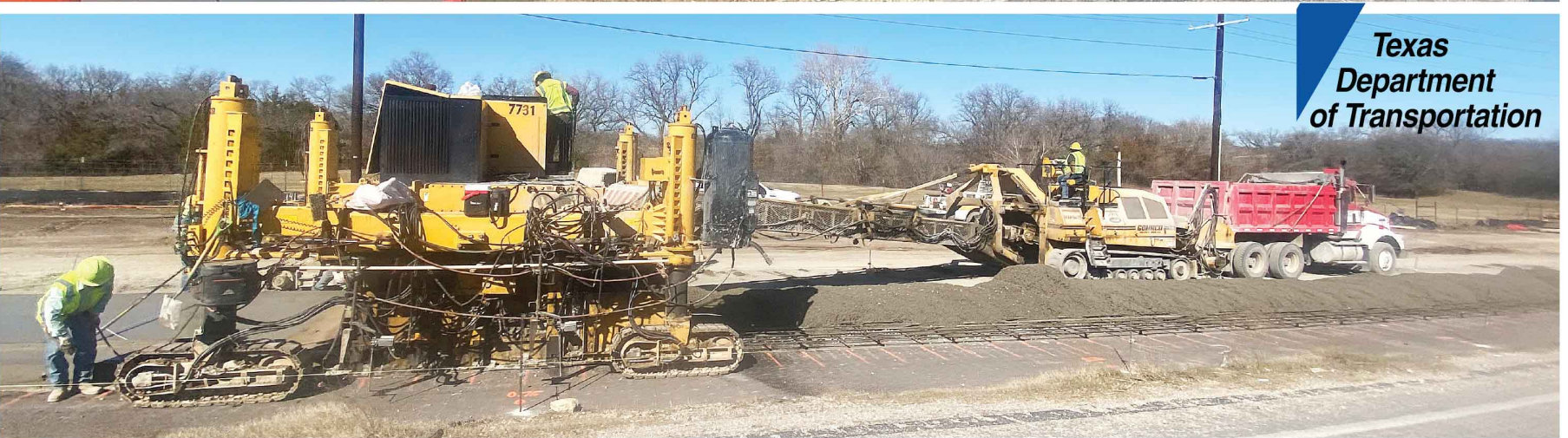

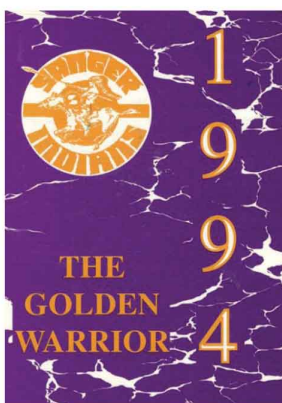



TxDOT contractor Webber pours concrete on FM 455 West near Clear Creek, recently. They've built a cement plant near Pit Stop in Bolivar. Dump trucks are used to transport the concrete and it is unloaded on a piece of equipment with a conveyor belt and distributed in a long row. Then a machine spreads it while work-

ers complete the finishing look. The concrete is 10" thick. TxDOT is widening FM 455 from Bolivar (FM 2450) to Marion Road, just east of Sanger High School. When finished, it will be two lanes each way. The pavement is being laid on top of asphalt for the entire project.

Batis said, "We are unsure what year the Sanger schools began publishing yearbooks for the students. Our earliest yearbook is from 1934 and have no information that any were published prior to this time. Should anyone know what year the annuals began, we would appreciate that information."

There are plans for making these yearbooks available for viewing to the public in the near future. In the meantime, the yearbooks are a popular part of the Sanger Museum and they invite you to come visit on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

York and Moore file for School Board, deadline to file is February 16

The annual City and School Board General Election will be held Saturday, May 4, 2024 to elect a Mayor (Thomas Muir) and Councilmembers for Place 2 (Gary Bilyeu) and Place 4 (Allen Chick) for a two-year term. Places 2 (Ann Marie Afflerbach) and Place 3 (Sarah York) are up for School Board. Muir confirmed through via text to the Sanger News, recently he is planning on running for another 2-year term. As of Wednesday, Feb. 7, he had not officially filed. Chick has turned in his paperwork for another term in Place 4 and Lisa Freeman has filed for Place 4 as his opponent. Bilyeu hasn't filed, but plans on seeking re-election, he confirmed this week. On School Board, York has turned in her election packet for Place 3, and Staci Moore has filed for Place 2 on the SISD Board of Directors.

Filing Period for City:

Applications will be available for pick-up for filing for a place on the ballot at Sanger City Hall, 502 Elm Street, Sanger, Texas. The first day to file for a place on ballot was January 17, 2024 at 7:30 AM. The last day

to file for a place on the ballot is February 16, 2024 by 5:00 PM. City Hall regular office hours are Monday - Thursday 7:30 AM - 5:00 PM and Friday 7:30 AM - 11:00 AM. The City Secretary's Office will be open until 5:00 PM on February 16, 2024. The location of next Election will be at Sanger Community Center - 101 Freese Street, Sanger, Texas 76262.

City of Sanger City Council Elected Officials and Terms:

The City Council consists of a Mayor and five Council Members, all of whom are elected at large. Positions are numbered one through five consecutively. The terms of the Mayor and Council members shall be for two years. The Mayor and Council Places 2 and 4, shall be elected in even numbered years, and Council Places 1, 3, and 5 shall be elected in odd numbered years. Regular City Council Meetings are on the first and third Monday of every month, unless the meeting falls on a holiday which then moves the meeting to Tuesday. Access agendas and minutes for all of the Sanger City Council meetings.

Qualifications / Eligibility to File for City:

City of Sanger Home Rule Charter Section 3.04 Code of Ordinances; Each candidate for an elective office shall meet the following qualifications:

- Be a qualified voter
- Be 21 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable
- Must have resided in the State for twelve months and within the City limits for twelve months immediately preceding the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot
- Shall not be employed by the City
- Shall meet all other eligibility requirements of the Texas Election Code

Sanger ISD Board of Trustees Information:

The Sanger ISD Board of Trustees consists of seven Board Members elected to serve, without compensation, for overlapping terms of three years each.

Requirements to Hold SISD Office:

Be a qualified (registered) voter [Educ. Code 11.061(b)]; Take the official oath of office [Educ. Code 11.061(a)]; Serve without compensation [Educ. Code 11.061(d)]; Have been a continuous resident of the state for twelve months and a resident of the district for six months prior to the last date a candidate may file to be listed on the ballot [Election Code 141.001(a)(5)].

SISD Application Procedures:

Any individual who meets the requirements to hold office may pick up a filing packet from the Sanger ISD Superintendent's Office at 601 Elm Street, Sanger, Texas 76266.

Applications must be signed, notarized, and state the place for which the applicant is a candidate (i.e., Place 2, Place 3, ...). All applications filed are public records and open to inspection upon request. Completed applications must be filed at the Sanger ISD Superintendent's Office. Any questions about the application process should be sent to Robbie Meeks at rmeeks@sangerisd.net.
